Greetings from all the Voyageurs and Dames of the Grand Voiture du Missouri. We would like to extend to each and every one of you an open invitation to attend our Central States Promenade 2011.

All the fun and festivities will start on Thursday, April 28, 2011 and will be held at the Embassy Suites Hotel Kansas City International Airport, 7640 NW Tiffany Springs Parkway, Kansas City, MO 64153. There are only **seven handicap accessible rooms** available so if you fit into this category, please ask early because these are on a first come, first served basis. Make all your room reservations directly with the hotel reservations numbers, or you can mail in the attached room reservation form. **There are seven smoking rooms in this hotel.** Small pets are allowed but cost \$10.00 per day.

Kansas City bills itself as the "Heart of America." The city is famous for its stockyards, saxophone player Charlie "Bird" Parker and his Kansas City-style bebop, and some of the best barbecue in the world. The city has more boulevards than Paris and more working fountains (212 and counting) than any city but Rome. Giving Kansas City its second nickname: "The City of Fountains."
