The Dr's told us it was in Stage 1 and it was confined. He went in the VA Hosp. Tues the 20th and had a Whipple. This was radical surgery but we were told two days later (thursday) that they got it all and he was to go home and recover and be cancer free. Early Sat. I went in and he was already in trouble...he threw clots, and they shut down his heart, he left us 4:30 pm Sat..

Resolution

WHEREAS, The membership of La Societe des Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux has continued to decline over the past several years and

WHEREAS, The reduction in membership is hindering our ability to maintain our programs as well as our ability to support the American Legion and

WHEREAS, La Societe became a fully independent veterans group in 1959, and

WHEREAS, Broadening La Societe's membership criteria harms no group or person, and

WHEREAS, This measure does not diminish the ritual, charity, selectivity, or honor at the heart of La Societe, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Article IV Section 1 - WHO MAY BECOME MEMBERS be changed to read as follows:

Membership is open to all American Legion Members and all Honorably Discharged Veterans and all Military Personnel currently serving our country,

and be it further RESOLVED, that the Avocat National make all changes necessary to bring the balance of the constitution in agreement with the changes made to Article IV, Section 1.

And be it further RESOLVED, that this Resolution be presented to the Grande Promenade in June, 2008, for consideration and voted on for adoption and passed to Voiture Nationale for presentation to the Nationale Promenade to be held in Orlando Florida, September 2008 for consideration.
