CHILD WELFARE

Greetings Voyageurs,

Thanksgiving has past and the Christmas Holiday season has begun, I would like to wish all Voyageurs and their Families a Merry Christmas and thank you for all you do in support of the Programs of La Société. This is always a busy time for our Locale Child Welfare programs. Many Children are in need of assistance during the holidays either for food or gifts. I encourage all Locales to reach out and assist these needy families if possible. I would also encourage thorough investigation and follow up into assistance request's to ensure the need is valid and these hard earned funds are used to assist needy Children as this season, unfortunately, also brings out the worst in some people in the form of scams and just plain dishonesty. If you have not purchased 2017 child welfare pins please contact me msgsgt2@yahoo.com or the National Directeur. The pins are still of the angel design this year and are white in color. I have a about 40 pins left from my original consignment so if your locale would like to participate in supporting The Artery Trust fund please feel free to contact me . As most may know, the primary function of the Charles W. Ardery Trust Fund is to provide reimbursements of funds expended by a Voiture Locale or a Grande Voiture in meeting the emergent needs of children 17 years of age or younger. Emergent is defined as: A situation which has developed of a serious nature demanding prompt attention." This situation may arise out of natural disasters, i.e., floods, tornadoes, hurricane, fire, etc. Emergent cases are given prime consideration and are undertaken by the Local Voiture where established agencies, (Red Cross, churches, welfare, etc.), are unable to move rapidly or cannot act at all. However, this aid is not intended to replace or supplement that assistance which may be available through established agencies. If you have a large case such as house fire or flooding, these funds can be requested from the National Directeur. These funds will be converted to another specified program if not used during

the year. In closing I again wish everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. I thank you for your service to this great country and your continued service to your communities.
