I want to thank everyone for all they do for this organization. I'm proud to be a part of the 40

and 8 and everything it represents. There are times that we take for granted everything that happens behind the scenes. We do this as Veterans and our commitment to this great organization. Everyone's effort and dedication are truly appreciated.

I had the opportunity to attend the Missouri Veterans Commission and MAVO meeting in Jefferson City on 25 Jan 2022. There was a MAVO Rally on 26 January 2022 in the Rotunda in the State Capitol to bring awareness and discuss with our State Legislators the importance of a fully funded Missouri Veterans Commission (MVC). The funding includes operation and maintenance of State Veterans Homes, State Cemeteries, Veteran Service Officers Program and Veterans Grant Programs. Our Missouri Veterans Homes (7) are at 50% capacity due to staff shortages (CNA's, LPN's and RN's) and the underfunding of our Medical Professionals in Veteran Facilities. Our Veterans deserve better. This reiterates the importance of one of our core programs: Nurses Training.

#### **Military Uniform Flag**

#### The Real Reason Why it is Backwards on Uniforms

For over 230 years, whenever our troops have marched, sailed, flown, swam, or paradropped into battle, the American flag has been there. Between the Mexican and Civil Wars, it was carried out front by a flag bearer. In later conflicts, the standard was converted into a patch worn on the service member's right shoulder. And it's always "backwards." Most Americans see the flag every day, flying outside government buildings, schools, and other institutions. We saluted it in primary school, and we know what it looks like. The blue field of white stars is in the top left corner, with red and white stripes making up the rest of the right and bottom.

So, did someone make a mistake on these uniforms? Actually, the flag patch is worn backwards to give others the same impression it did when it was first carried into battle. The momentum of the flag bearer would leave the flag streaming behind, appearing backwards to enemies, or anyone else close enough to catch a glimpse. According to Army Regulation 670-1: "The American flag patch is to be worn, right or left shoulder, so that the star field faces forward, or to the flag's own right. When worn in this manner, the flag is facing to the observer's right, and gives the effect of the flag flying in the breeze as the wearer moves forward."

This feature is unique to U.S. military uniforms. No other country in the world maintains this symbolic standard. The next time you see an American service member in uniform, show them your gratitude, and take pride in the fact that the flag is always on the advance, never retreating.



Greetings from all the Voyageurs and Dames of the Grand Voiture du Oklahoma. We would like to extend to each and every one of you an open invitation to attend our Central States Promenade 2022.

Please ensure the widest dissemination of this information to all your Voitures, Cabanes, Voyageurs and Dames.

All the fun and festivities will start on Thursday, April 28, 2022, and will be held at the Wyndham Garden Hotel, 2101 S. Meridian Ave, Oklahoma City, OK 73108. Their phone number is 1-405-685-4000. The room rate is \$92.00 per night plus tax. We have reserved 30 rooms for this event so make your reservations early as all rooms not reserved by April 15, 2022 will be returned to the hotel for their normal bookings. Be sure to mention that you are with the 40&8 Central States Promenade. There are **handicap accessible rooms** available so if you fit into this category, please ask early because these are on a first come, first served basis. **Make all your room reservations directly with the hotel reservations number.** Pets are allowed with \$50-\$75 pet fee depending on size.

Individual registrations for this event will still be \$85.00 per person and registration kit includes our Friday evening B-B-Q meal, our Saturday evening banquet, your Central States Promenade 2022 Pin, your Souvenir Program Book, and of course, the Grande du Oklahoma's own Hospitality Room. Please fill out the registration form completely when returning your reservations.

For those of you who have never been to the Oklahoma City area and want to strike out on your own, we will have maps of the city for your use, along with flyers and pamphlets that describe local attractions. The Bricktown Area and Canal in Oklahoma City are popular tourist destinations. Several casinos are within a short drive from the hotel. We have great shopping too. Plan to arrive here early and check out the OKC area.

Naturally, for those of you who like to stay close to home, our hospitality rooms will be open for your pleasure at the following times: Thursday 4:00 pm to midnight, Friday 2 pm to 5 pm and will open after the BBQ until midnight, Saturday after the Promenade 3:00 P.M to 5:00 P.M. and will open after the Banquet until midnight.

For those of you who intend to fly into Oklahoma City Airport, the hotel is less than 5 minutes from the airport, and they have an airport shuttle bus to pick you up. Just give the hotel a call when you arrive.

The BBQ will take place on Friday 29 April at the Wyndham Garden Hotel. The Voyageur's Luncheon and the Women's Luncheon on Saturday will each cost \$25.00. We hope you will attend.

The meals will be:

- BBQ green salad, Cole slaw, fried chicken, beef brisket, baked beans with bacon, fried okra, dinner rolls, and fruit cobbler and triple chocolate cake.
- Ladies Luncheon Citrus Chicken green salad, grilled chicken breast marinated in orange, lemon and lime juice, topped with fruit chutney, grilled asparagus, wild rice, and strawberry shortcake.
- Voyageurs Luncheon Grilled Chicken Breast green salad, marinated chicken breast with lemon pepper demi-glaze, herb roasted potatoes, Julienne vegetables, and strawberry cake.
- Banquet -
  - Choice of Burgundy Beef Tips green salad, tender sirloin tips in a rich burgundy sauce served over egg noodles, with French beans and apple pie.
  - or Chicken Marsala green salad, breaded chicken breast topped with mushroom Marsala wine sauce, with roasted red skinned potatoes, steamed broccoli, and red velvet cake.
