#### SPRING WRECK DERBY

The Grande is once again going to have a fundraiser at the Spring Grande Cheminot & Wreck.

Each Voiture that is represented at the banquet will have a Jockey and one decorated Stick (Hobby) Horse entry. The more realistic the better, Owners of the horse wear vour silks (colors). Each Voiture will decorate their Stick horse and select their own Jockey to ride in the Stick Horse Derby Parade. There will be a \$20.00 per Voiture entry fee. If a Voiture does not participate in the Derby there will be a \$50.00 fine. At the banquet the men or women, dressed as Jockeys with their Stick Horses, will go around the audience to collect money to be used to feed the horses. Make sure your Horse has a full belly or you may find your Jockey and Stick Horse at the bar instead of the starting gate. The Jockey who collected the most money will win a prize. Next, the Jockey and Stick Horse will

run 2 races. The races will be 10 (1 foot) squares and each Jockey representative will roll a die and the Jockey will move that many squares. Be careful, if your Horse number comes up you lose that turn. While the Stick Horses are getting into position at the starting gate, players can place their bets. \$2.00 bet for Win only. 50/50 split 50% to the Winning ticket holders and 50% to the Grande.

Stick Horses will be available for \$10 on Saturday or you can bring your own. Remember you will need to decorate the Horse.

Please plan on joining fellow Voyageurs at the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Spring Wreck, Stick Horse Decorating and Racing Contest. Brush off your STETSON; polish your Boots and Joy in on the fun.

# DISTINGUISHED VOYAGEUR AWARD

It is that time of the year again when your deserving candidates for Distinguished Voyageur should be submitted to the Grand Directeur. The nomination forms are furnished by the Grand Correspondant for any Voiture Local wishing to submit a candidate.

There shall be no more than three Awards per year – two active and one posthumously. Only one nomination may be submitted each year from each Voiture Local. The committee will consider nominations for two additional years if not accepted in the first year, but must be resubmitted after three years.

The nominations must be in the hands of the committee before the Grande Voiture du Missouri Spring Cheminot. The Voiture Local is responsible for attendance of award winner or family member, if posthumous, at the Grand Promenade for award presentation.

Voyageurs Militaire of La Société des

Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux with ten years or more are eligible. Grand Chefs de Gare Passé du Missouri are not eligible for this award.

Awards will be in the form of an "In Appreciation" certificate with citation appropriately engrossed and bound at a cost not to exceed \$100.00, each.

Voiture Locales are not obligated to submit nominations each year nor is the committee obligated to make awards each year. I know we have some exceptional voyageurs out there in our locals, so lets honor them with the Distinguished Voyageur Award. Get your nominations in now before it is too late.
