SPRING WRECK DERBY

The Grande is once again going to have a

fundraiser at the Spring Grande Cheminot & Wreck.

Each Voiture that is represented at the banquet will have a Jockey and one decorated Stick (Hobby) Horse entry. The more realistic the better. Owners of the horse wear your silks (colors) Each Voiture will decorate their Stick horse and select their own Jockey to ride in the Stick Horse Derby Parade. There will be a \$50.00 per Voiture entry fee. If a Voiture does not participate in the Derby there will be a \$50.00 fine. At the banquet the men or women, dressed as Jockeys with their Stick Horses, will go around the audience to collect money to be used to feed the horses. Make sure your Horse has a full belly or you may find your Jockey and Stick Horse at the bar instead of the starting gate. The Jockey who collected the most money will win a prize. Next, the Jockey and Stick Horse will run 2 races. The races will be 10 (1 foot) squares and each Jockey representative will roll a die and the Jockey will move that many squares. Be careful, if your Horse number comes up you lose that turn. There will not be any betting.

Stick Horses will be available for \$10 on Saturday or you can bring your own. If you want to buy one then let Bob Phillips know you will need one. Remember you will need to decorate the Horse.

Please plan on joining fellow Voyageurs at the Spring Wreck, Stick Horse Decorating and Racing Contest. Brush off your STETSON; polish your Boots and join in on the fun.

The "2019 PETITE COMMUNIQUE" from Voiture Nationale can only be obtained by downloading it from the internet at Voiture National's web site at http://www.fortyandeight.org/forms-petite/. I have either emailed you a copy or have enclosed a copy. Use the new 2019 forms for the Locale Directeur's to fill out for all the activities your Locale has done for the past year. Provide the forms to your Directeur's to fill them out and send them to the Grand Directeur's by June 15th. When the Directeur has completely filled out the report, make a copy of the report and give one to the Locale Correspondant for the Voiture's file and send the other to the Grand Directeur in charge of the Program. If the Directeur has nothing to report, the report should be marked as "NO REPORT" and still send it to the Grande Directeur. Let's all Voiture's make a sincere effort to complete all of the reports. By not filling out the reports you are shortchanging your Voiture by not telling the Grande everything your Voiture is doing. I know all of the Voiture's are doing more than everyone thinks.

DOORS of OPPORTUNITY

In La Société, we might consider that those who walk through the door of opportunity when it swings open are more successful than those who do not. But what is the secret to getting through the door of opportunity?

First we must look at what do we mean by opportunity and what opportunity means to us in the Forty and Eight.

A basic and kind of standard definition is that opportunity is a set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something. Another way of looking at is a favorable *combination* of circumstances. There is a quote I see every once in a while... "For every problem there is an opportunity." My favorite is... ""The trouble with opportunity is that it always comes disguised as hard work." Here's a great quote from Milton Berle... "If opportunity doesn't knock, build a door".

So if we read and think about those quotes, it is not a great leap to think about how opportunity, in many ways can affect the success or failure of our Locales and Grands. I want to focus on two areas, membership and public relations, but this ambiguous door of opportunity can affect us in all areas. Membership... Of course we mean membership growth by recruitment and retention, making goal, obtaining sustain-ing members who faithfully renew and attend promenades and volunteer. How many new members are behind that membership door of opportunity? We won't know unless we open it!! We cannot rely on any potential new member on the other side of the door to open their door and come to us. Some say "opportunity only knocks once". We can't stand in front of that door and wait for a knock.

What kind of membership opportunities are out there? This has been cussed and discussed, talked and written about, memos, letters, texts and emails. You see, we already know what is on the other side of that door, we know how to open it, and we know who is on the other side but sometimes hesitate or are not prepared to open it. When you step thru that door and find a potential member


you must be prepared with knowledge and tools. Knowledge of our organization's goals, aspirations, commitments, programs, history and membership requirements. Have applications, literature, folders, pins, membership cards, anything to show and tell. Where is your Chapeau? Consider keeping it in your vehicle—bet it has pins on it, marching medal, bars, etc. A great way to start a conversation about La Société. Public Relations... You know, PR is not generally thought of as a "program" of La Société. We all know PR is important but it is rarely talked about beyond newsletters. I've had to think about who or what would be behind that "door of opportunity". Behind that door is your Locale or Grand's reputation, good-will, your standing in the community, your public service and of course the media.

Public relations only becomes relevant once you step through it. Now some may say this is a difficult door to open and many Locales may not be prepared to open it. You see before you step through you any door you must be prepared for what is on the other side. Lets focus on the media... When you go thru that door you should have media lists, fact sheets on your organization, press releases, etc. You should also have motivation. AND the person who steps to the other side must be someone who can articulate and present your Locale or Grand in a positive and professional manner. Remember these doors of opportunity are always open, never locked and you have to have the desire to step through. If you become prepared in some of the ways I've described above, maybe your doors will automatically open.
