### George B. Boland Trust Fund

The George B. Boland Nurses Training Scholarship Trust Fund is one of the most underutilized programs in the 40/8. The fund is underutilized because it is misunderstood. The Boland Nurses Scholarship Trust was founded to provide additional scholarship support to those Voitures Locale who have exhausted their scholarship funds but who will have qualified individuals applying for scholarships. The trust is administered by Voiture Nationale, and all determinations regarding the awarding of scholarships grants are made by the Boland Trust Committee consisting of three (3) members of La Société. Only those Voitures Locale who have an local Nurses Training Program in place may apply to the Boland Trust for further assistance, as the Trust Fund is intended as a a supplement to, and not a replacement for, a local nurses training program. Guidance for this program is provided by Holly Weinbrecht at Voiture National. Holly's contact information is "hweinbrecht@fortyandeight.org", or by calling Voiture National. When first viewed the application process appears complicated and difficult be it is not, like many things it is only difficult the first time. Information can be found at the National website fortyandeight.org under Program's Boland Trust Fund.

### POW/MIA Survivor Scholarship Fund

The purpose of the POW/MIA Program is to raise funds in HONOR of the Servicemen and Women who were Prisoners of War, or considered Missing in Acton while serving in the Defense of the United States of America, or its Allies during times of armed conflict. Merchandise is sold, and monies are collected and donated facilitate the formation and continuance of a Scholarship Trust Fund for the direct descendants of VERIFIABLE POW/MIA Servicemen and Women. These Scholarships are limited to the Veteran, the Spouse of the Veteran, children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren of the Veteran.

The number of Scholarships, as well as the amount of the scholarship is determined by the amount of funds and donations received by the Program throughout the year. The minimum amount for a Scholarship will be no less than \$500.00 but can go as much as \$1000.00 each. Applications are submitted by applicants with certified proof of eligibility, and certified proof of enrollment in an intuition attending. This will include transcripts of grades. Applications must be submitted No Later Than July 15th of the current year. A new, complete application must be submitted each year, and may do so for up to four awards.

It is incumbent upon everyone to support all of our programs through acquisition of the merchandise that is available each and every year. Take the time to review each program within the 40 et 8, and when your program Directeur asks for your support, please do so with the purchase of their merchandise.
