

Fr. Capodanno was a Maryknoll priest, assigned to Hong Kong and Shanghai in China. He served the poor there and furthered the welfare of the people by building schools, supporting families and evangelizing the people he met. He asked for, and was granted permission to become a Navy Chaplain. He was assigned to Vietnam, where he stayed as close as possible to the Marine units, following them even to the battlefield. It was in one fire fight that he was wounded while giving comfort and last rites to a wounded marine. He noticed the medic was taking fire while treating another wounded man. Without a thought for his own safety, he advanced to shield the medic while taking 24 further bullet wounds. He then died among the men he stewarded so ably. Fr. Capodanno was awarded one of only 6 Medal of Honors given to Chaplains. A cause for his elevation to Sainthood is in place.

Post 1974 is named for Fr. Capodanno, which we feel is a great honor. The post wishes, therefore, to extend this invitation to you so that Fr. Capodanno may be remembered.

GRAND CHEMINOT, JULY 2, 2016
RAMADA PLAZA HOTEL, SPRINGFIELD, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Dave Bexten, opened the Grand Cheminot at 1:00 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and as always a prayer by Grand Aumonier John Kopp.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passé showed that eight answered. Roll call of the Grand Cheminot showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call so they paid a fine. Absent was Voiture's 3, 447, 520, 760, 966, 1395, 1402, and 1403.

Grand Avocat Rich Heigert said we will use the same rules as outlined in Roberts Rules.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by Janis Hartley, that the Grand Spring Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated he received resolutions from Terry Lanning for Grand Correspondant and Commissaire Intendant National.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, David Voyles, stated the finance report was passed out and he discussed it.

Grand Chef de Train Berkley said we are at 94% and called on the Sous Chef de Trains to report on their Voiture's, to which A. J. Noonan stated his Voiture's were 10 short, Janice Hartley said her Voiture's were 2 short, Calvin Bumgarner said his Voiture's were 25 short, and Richard Pack said his Voiture's were 23 short. The Grand has a total membership of 912.

Cheminot Nationale Ralph Turner said to let him know if anyone is interest in a National office.

The highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 38 had their rolling stock out and about, on February 28th was the official closure ceremony of Soldiers Memorial for rehab for 2 ½ years, on May 21st had a fundraiser BBQ, on May 18th had its annual memorial service, will have a trivia night on August 27, 2016 at Genesis Banquet Center; Voiture 130 is still selling towels and bought a trailer for the towels, they are getting some more voyagers to help out; Voiture 333 had a fundraiser on May 21, 2016 for major renovations to the Box Car, estimated it will cost about \$20,000, they now have \$15,500, have 2 nurses in Training, they have their own web site; Voiture 448 had a BBQ on June 4th at Cabela's, had a Christmas Party and Easter Party at Marygrove kids home; Voiture 460 have 16 nurses at \$8,000, spent \$512 on some local sports teams, \$866 on several children in need, \$1,700 on several occasions for Americanism, membership at 106%; Voiture 760 2 nurses in training, had a xmas party for kids \$150, 1 boy to Cadet Patrol \$350, \$250 for Springfield Reunion, \$1,500 for Ozark Food Harvest; Voiture 1292, participated in Memorial Day activities, had a Hog Roast, had a BBQ for Nurses Training; Voiture 1321 has their cooker out in Herculanum once a month thru October at Buckheits General Store, 5 nurses in training, sponsored another nurse for a Boland Trust scholarship, at 100% membership; Voiture 1379 will have their ChickNic on August 20, 2016, is having a raffle for gift cards for Nurses Training; Voiture 1541 will have their Car Show on August 20, 2016, Wolfie sent in money for a Nationale raffle and received a pocket knife, installation will be on August 24th at Wentzville Legion Post, conducted a Calvin Kane ceremony, flew 40/8 colors on Memorial Day at Bauer Cemetery, helped the Marine Corps Devil dogs with their first Night at the Races, will have their Christmas party on December 14th at 1800, donated \$50 in memory of Gary Reno for the POW/MIA Highway fund.

Grand Historien Richard Pack said he received one Voiture History book, Voiture 1541.

Grand Avocat Richard Heigert said some Voiture Constitutions need to be updated.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Benjamin Sargent said he received 8 reports showing cash spent of \$125,000. 1st place went to 1321, 2nd place went to 460 and 3rd place went to 1379.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities George Ridley - Terry Lanning reported for George. 1st place went to 448, 2nd place went to 1541 and 3rd place went to 333.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley said there are 81 Nurses in Training in the Grande and spent \$61,797.51. The Grande has 4 Nurses in the Boland program. 1st place went to 3, 2nd place went to 460 and 3rd place went to

1395. Jim offered a notion to give the fines (\$281.91) the PG's collected to a nurse in training. Jim has someone in mind. Notion passed.

Grand Directeur Aumonier John Kopp said to let him know if a Grand Officer is sick or passes away so he can send them a card.

Grand Publiciste Bob Emery said he received 8 reports. 1st place went to 448, 2nd place went to 460 and 3rd place went to 333.

Grand Directeur Americanism Bob Emery said he received 13 reports. 1st place went to 1321, 2nd place went to 38 and 3rd place went to 460.

Grand Directeur Box Car Ed said he received 8 reports. 1st place went to 333, 2nd place went to 1541 and 3rd place went to 1321, and the traveling trophy went to 333.

Grand Directeur Carville Star Mike Scruby said he received 7 reports for a total of \$2,624. 1st place went to 1379, 2nd place went to 460 and 3rd place went to 1541.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA Frank Angelo said he received 7 reports. 1st place went to 460, 2nd place went to 448 and 3rd place went to 1321. He has 55 pins to sell, so if anyone wants any let him know.

Grand Directeur Ritual Rose Noonan said she received 7 reports. 1st place went to 1324, 2nd place went to 38 and 3rd place went to 448.

Grand VAVS Chairman Tom Goodin - Richard Pack reported for Tom and said Tom received 5 reports. 1st place went to 460, 2nd place went to 1541 and 3rd place went to 333.

Sous Grand Directeur Youth Sports Ann Roberts written report said 1st place went to 460, 2nd place went to 1321 and 3rd place went to 1379.

Grand Sous Correspondant, Grant Willis said the Grand Chef and any other articles are due to him by the end of the month. The next newsletter will go out August 1st.

Time and Place Committee member Kevin Johnson said the next 4 events will be held at the Ramada Plaza Hotel in Springfield.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Chairman Grant Willis said he will present one at the banquet.

Distinguished Guest Committee Richard Heigert stated Bill Simpson Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer had to leave this morning to go back home. He came in on Friday and Bill said he had a good time.

Old Business - Central States Ad Hoc Committee of Richard Heigert, Art Wilson and David Voyles. Rich said the Committee received two bids, one from the Ramada Plaza Hotel with a room rate of \$87 and the other from the Kansas City Embassy Suites with a room rate of \$119. Rich offered a notion to hold Central States 2018 at the Ramada Plaza Hotel in Springfield, seconded by Ralph and passed. Rich also said some of the number of room nights and the number of people at the dinners are going to be reduced and Rich will talk to the Ramada Hotel about that and see if it affects the room price.

New Business - None

Good of the Grande Voiture - Ernie Parker from V333 asked if any individuals want to make a donation to the State Box Car then he will have a bucket at the banquet. If the donations and Grande fine money is \$500 or more, then a plaque will be in the Grande's name.
