

SPRING GRAND CHEMINOT, MARCH 28, 2009 Howard Johnson Plaza Hotel BANQUET ROOM, Kansas City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare, Robert W. Phillips, opened the Spring Grand Cheminot sharply at 1 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by acting Grand Aumonier, Grant Willis.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest were a pain in the rear. Doc Buzzard Ebersold was not present and Grand Commissaire Intendant Ebersold blamed it on the Grand Chef de Train Reno and Reno should pay the fine. This comment lead to a lot of voyageurs saying Reno should pay their fine also. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that ten-answered roll call. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Will the Voyageurs ever learn how to answer roll call? Therefore there were many fines collected. Absent were Voitures 292, 293, 333, 447, 460, 520, 848, 966, 1395, and 1402.

Notion offered by Don Fligge, seconded by Virgil Morice, that the Grand Fall Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning reported he received a notice that Joe Ser III from Grande du Virginia is a candidate for Chef de Chemin de Fer. Terry sent out to all Grand Directeurs and top Grande Officers a request that they create a job description for their office. There are several that have not submitted theirs yet, and should do so right away. Terry announced there is a folder to be picked up by each Grande Directeur concerning Locale Voiture reports. Each Locale Voiture also has a folder concerning their reports, new officers and delegates for the Grande Promenade.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning announced he had a resolution for Gary Reno for Vice President of the Central States Promenade. Notion offered to approve the resolution by George Ridley, seconded by Grant Willis .. passed. Terry also has a resolution for Terry Lanning for Grand Correspondant.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Larry Ebersold, reported that the finance report, with a few minor incorrect dates, which he will pay for, was placed on the chairs and asked if there were any questions. Notion offered by Art Wilson, second by Rich Heigert, to accept the Finance report subject to audit... passed.

Grand Chef de Train, Gary L. Reno, reported on the current Grande membership. Gary stated that the Grande has 1,109 members, 90%. There are seven Voitures that are at or over 100%. Great job.

Grand Cheminot reports were given or turned in by Voitures 38, 130, 333, 448, 760, 1292, 1321, 1379, and 1541. Some of the highlights are Voiture 38 has 4 or 5 PG's ready to wreck and they will be starting up their BBQ's, in April, so come by and get some; Voiture 130 had hosted the Washington Birthday Party and everyone had a great time; Voiture 333 distributed 200 flags to school children, they visit the VA Hospital in Columbia twice a week and the Veterans home in Warrensburg each week and donate items, their annual patriotic banquet with the Chef de Chemin de Fer will be on May 9, on Valentines Day they gave 2,000 signed valentines to the VA Hospital in Columbia, they gave \$1,200 worth of trophies to the Smith-Cotton JROTC; Voiture 448 will have a BBQ at Post 111 on June 5 and 6, 2009; Voiture 760 has 4 nurses in training, they assisted a family that had a fire, buying \$800 of clothing for the kids, adopted 10 vets at Mt. Vernon Veterans Home for \$500, and paid the insurance for a Veterans Parade for \$500; Voiture 1292 has 6 nurses in training and will have a BBQ on June 20, 2009, and one boy in Boys State; Voiture 1379 has 2 nurses in training and wrecked 4 PG's today; Voiture 1541 had their Xmas party, coon supper, and night at the races, they have 3 nurses in training, and 3 boys going to Boys State.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities, Norm Gentry, reported he put some information in each of the Locale Voitures packets concerning Voiture Activities. Note that on one of the documents it states the Voiture reports are due to the Grande on July 25, 2009, that should be June 15, 2009.

Grand Chef de Gare wanted to complement everyone for their help in putting on a good wreck. There were 7 PG's wrecked.

Grand Directeur Box Car, Bill Evans, stated he has pins if anyone needs any. Also those Voitures that have not sent their money in for their pins needs to do so.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA, Dave Diaz, stated the most controversial issue of all veterans' topics is the POW/MIA issue. Those who are missing or captured must be accounted for, to give some comfort to their loved ones. While in reality the POW/MIA symbol has become the standard for those who served and those who are now serving. The POW/MIA flag flies in the rotunda of our nation's capitol. We as voyageurs should encourage everyone to fly the POW/MIA flag at their homes, offices, and businesses. This important issue will never go away as long as we have comrades unaccounted for. When we fail to get accounting for our brave men and women, then we as a nation are doomed. Current statistics for MIA's in Southeast Asia 1,742, Korea 8,056, Cold War 123, WWII 78,773 (74,384 unaccounted for 6,043 buried at sea) WWI 4,452. The 40/8 has a POW/MIA survivors scholarship program that is available to those dependents who qualify. POW/MIA pins are now available and have emailed the Directeur Nationale POW/MIA but have not received a response.

Grand Directeur Ritual, John Partin, stated Nationale has asked for help in creating a new Nationale password. Let him know of any ideas you have.

Grand Directeur Special Awards, David Brazie, sent his report in. Terry

Grand Directeur Special Awards, David Brazie, sent his report in. Terry read it. Wanted: Nominations for Hero of the Year. I know I sound like a broken record, but I have received no nominations for Hero of the Year. We have 20 Voitures in the state, surely, there is at least one person in the state who has done something heroic. I realize that there are far more important things on your agenda than this, but this is important. Please think about it. If you need the forms necessary, feel free to contact me. (Note there has been one nomination for Law Officer of the Year and it has been approved and forwarded to Nationale).

Grand Directeur Youth Sports, David Christian, said some of the Voitures have pins outstanding and need to send him their money.

Sous Correspondant, Grant Willis, said to send him any articles and flyers to be put in the Grand Newsletter.

Time & Place Committee, Art Wilson, reported that the Grande Promenade (June 26-28,2009) and the Homecoming (October 2-4, 2009) would also be held here at the Howard Johnson Plaza Hotel.

Grand Chef de Gare Phillips called on Al Sullivan, Grand Directeur POW/MIA du Kansas, to speak on the Central States Promenade. The Central States Promenade will be in Wichita, Kansas in 2009 at the Best Western Hotel. He left some Central States forms if anyone needs them. He hopes everyone comes, they are planning a good one.

New Business - Grand Chef de Gare Phillips wants to make the following Grand Promenade Chairmen appointments: Credentials Gary Reno, Constitution Don Fligge, Nominations Chubs Buckley, Resolutions Grant Willis, and Audit Ray Brodzinski with members Sam Guenther and Rich Heigert. Chubs made a notion to approve the appointments, seconded by George Ridley .. passed.

Grand Chef de Gare Phillips passed out a pin to the Chef of Voiture 1541 for attaining 100%. Bob Eisenbath accepted the pin on the behalf of their Chef.

Grant Willis stated the Grand needs a new banner for the west side of the state, which would allow one for each side of the state. Grant offered a notion to purchase a banner up to \$200, seconded by Virgil Morice ..passed. Rich Heigert offered a notion to use the fines from today and further until the banner is paid for, seconded by Art Wilson ..passed.

Don Fligge offered a notion to increase the budget for Truman Day from \$200 to \$300, since the Grande will have to pay one extra nights lodging for the Chef de Chemin de Fer. There was some discussion about the Grande paying for the extra nights lodging since the Chef de Chemin de Fer is then going from Truman Day to a function at Voiture 333. Notion was seconded by Grant Willis and passed. The Grand Correspondant offered to write a letter to Voiture 333 and explain that in the future the Grand will only pay for one nights lodging for the Chef de Chemin de Fer coming in for Truman Day.

Under Good Of The Voiture, it was reported that a law is being considered on allowing gaming devices if a veteran's organization has a bingo license. A cold war certificate can be applied for.

Grand Chef de Gare Phillips closed the Spring Grand Cheminot in the proper manner at 2:25 PM.


