
If you have an event you would like for me to show up to (or to stay away from) please feel free to let me know.

#### SPRING WRECK DERBY

The Grande is once again going to sponsor a fundraiser at the Spring Grande Cheminot & Wreck, to help defray the cost of running the Grande.

This year, the fundraiser will focus on the Jockey. Each Voiture that is represented at the banquet will sponsor a Jockey. The more realistic the better, the Jockey will dress in their "Horse Racing Colors".
