GRANDE PROMENADE, JUNE 27, 2010 Truman Hotel, Jefferson City, Missouri

Grand Chef de Gare, Gary L. Reno, opened the Grande Promenade at 9:00~AM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier, Marvin Harper.

Roll call of officers showed a few more excused, a few more absent, and the rest claimed to be here. Many paid fines for acting up. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe, showed there were eleven present. Roll call of Voitures showed there was a quorum present. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 520, 966, and 1395. Rich Heigert gave the Rules of Procedure. Notion offered by Art Wilson, seconded by Virgil Morice, that the Rules of Procedure be followed...passed.

Notion offered by Rich Heigert, second by Virgil Morice, that the minutes of the June 28, 2009 Grande Promenade be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Chef Reno called on the Grande Promenade Committees starting with the Audit Committee chaired by Rich Heigert with the help of Sam Guenther and Robert Phillips. Also present were Grand Commissaire Intendant, David Christian, visitor Ed Jones, and Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning. Rich stated that the Audit took place on June 26, 2010 at the Truman Hotel at 9:00 AM. The Committee reviewed all deposits and disbursements and validated the Financial Report of June 26, 2010. They also reviewed the Money Market account reflecting a balance of \$1,369.69, plus 4 CD's. The Now Checking account had a balance of \$2,709.68. The total assets of the Grand as of June 26, 2010 are \$25,079.37. The committee also recommends that due to the volatility of the market that all Savings Certificates be renewed for 1 year. Notion offered by Rich, second by Ed Jones, to approve the Audit Committee Report as presented and to send the \$369 in fines collected during the year to the Missouri POW/MIA Scholarship Fund...passed.

Grand Chef Reno called on the Resolutions Committee chaired by Grant Willis. Grant reported that he opened the committee at 9:00am. Grant stated he had resolutions for Larry R. Ebersold for Grand Chef de Gare, David Christian for Grand Chef de Train, Ed Jones for Grand Commissaire Intendant, Terry L. Lanning for Grand Correspondant, and Terry L. Lanning for National Commissaire Intendant. The committee approved these resolutions. There were no other resolutions. It is the recommendation of the committee that the first four resolutions be read by the Correspondant during the election of officer's and voted on by the floor for a favorable vote. Grant offered a notion for the approval of the resolution for Terry Lanning for National Commissaire Intendant, seconded by Art Wilson ... passed. The committee adjourned at 9:05am. Grant offered a notion for the Resolutions Committees report to be accepted, seconded by Virgil Morice...passed.

Grand Chef Reno called on the Chairman of the Credential Committee, Larry Ebersold. Larry gave the voting strength for each Voitures and the overall for the Grand Voiture (81) and offered a notion, second by George Ridley, that the report be accepted as given...passed.

There was nothing submitted to the Constitution Committee, so Chairman Don Fligge had no report. Don offered a notion for his no report to be accepted, seconded by Art Wilson ... passed.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Committee, Ray Brodzinski, stated he had no report.

Grand Chef Reno called on the Chairman of the Nominating Committee, Chubs Buckley. Chubs reported that the meeting was held at the Truman Hotel and started at 10:00 AM. There were five in attendance at the meeting. The Nominating Committee recommends to the Grande the elected officers. Meeting adjourned at 10:15 AM. Chubs read the recommendation of the Committee for elective officers for 2010-2011.

Willis, Jr., Robert Phillips, Gary Reno, Terry Lanning and Dave Christian. With Clarence Buckley, Norm Reichel, Robert Eisenbath, Kevin Johnson, Rich Heigert being an Alternate. And with Gary Reno being the chairman of the delegation...passed.

Grand Chef Reno relieved the members of the Grande Promenade Committees. Newly elected Larry Ebersold said he is taking the position very responsibly. He said the Past Grand Chef's have offered their help and he appreciates that. He wanted to thank Voiture 1292 and 1403 for their help. Larry then offered a notion to have the person pay \$1 per year that has passed since they took Bull Ebersold, seconded and passed. It was stated that Art Wilson has it.

GRAND CHEMINOT, JUNE 26, 2010 Truman Hotel, Jefferson City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare, Gary L. Reno, opened the Grand Cheminot at 1:03 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier, Marvin Harper. Grand Chef de Gare Reno paid for being late and saying "two" instead of "Attention".

Grand Chef de Gare Reno introduced the Grande's Law and Order winner Mark DeGraffenreid, from the Missouri Highway Patrol. Voiture 333 nominated him.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest claimed to be here. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that ten answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed there was a quorum. A number of Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 520, 966, and 1395.

Rich Heigert gave the Rules of Procedure. Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by Virgil Morice, that the Grand Spring Cheminot minutes be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated he was passing around a sheet to be signed if you are going to the Promenade Nationale and another sheet to provide your email address. He stated there are a number of Voitures that have not provided their Officers and Directeurs for 2011 and they need to send those to him. He read a letter he received from Sous Directeur membership Region 2 Joseph Steil about membership.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, David Christian, reported that the finance report was placed on the chairs and asked if there were any questions. Notion offered by Don Fligge, second by Virgil Morice, to accept the Finance report subject to the audit report... passed.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno left the room and turned over the podium to Grand Chef de Train Larry Ebersold.

Grand Chef de Train Ebersold, reported on the current Grande membership. The Grande has 1234 members at 104.9%. Larry asked the Sous Chef de Trains to report to which Robert Fletcher, Chip Berkley, and John Paul Kopp reported on the Voitures they are assigned.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno came back into the room wearing a grass skirt that did not completely cover him in the rear. He had made a promise if the Grande went over the top he would wear a grass skirt. Thankfully he then left the room and changed back into his regular clothes.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno presented a Nationale pin to the Chef of Voiture 38 for going over the top. He said he was personally giving Voiture 520 \$25.00 for being the first Voiture over the top and Voiture 333 \$25.00 for having the most new voyageurs.

Grand Cheminot reports were given by Voiture 3, 38, 130, 333, 448, 460, 760, 1292, 1321, 1379, 1402, and 1541. Some of the highlights are Voiture 3 paid over \$20,000 in nurses in training scholarships, had their annual Nurses Training dinner, made contributions of \$2,500 to the Salvation Army, and sponsored eight boys to Boys State; Voiture 38 they are having their BBQ's at Ferguson's, Grant's Farm will not let them have their annual Children's picnic there this year, had a Christmas Party for 300 kids, they sponsor the local Naturalization ceremonies, had their annual Memorial Services with several other Voitures participating; Voiture 130 has 15 Nurses in Training, they are selling towels to fund their nurses training, Washington's Birthday Party was a lot of fun; Voiture 333 get about 110 at their Promenades, gave out 2,933 flags to First Graders, put over 10 gross of flags on veterans graves, had an open house for Viet Nam vets with 79 attending; Voiture 448 had a pigs in a blanket breakfast, had a BBQ in June, participated in a flag retirement ceremony; Voiture 460 gave \$3,570 to youth sports teams, child welfare \$6,488 for assistance after home fires and deposits on utilities, Children's Christmas party, \$19,000 for 36 Nurses in Training, and spent \$7,142 for new flags, assisted the Wounded Warriors program, JROTC; Voiture 760 took kids to the circus, adopted 10 vets, and sent 10 boys to Boys State; Voiture 1292 has 4 Nurses in Training, a Christmas party for 130 special kids, had a BBQ, and have voyageurs going to the VA Hospital to volunteer; Voiture 1321 has 5 Nurses in Training and their cooker is out; Voiture 1379 will have their Chic Nic on 8/28/10 at Wallace State Park, they have 1 Nurse in Training; Voiture

1402 has 2 Nurses in Training, gave 250 flags to students, gave a flag to the US Post Office; Voiture 1541 had an xmas party, coon supper, night at the races, are at 100% for Carville Star and Box Car, 1 boy to Boys State, performed 4 military funeral services.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare, Thomas Goodin, stated the 1^{st} place winner was Voiture 448, 2^{nd} place winner was Voiture 1321, and 3^{rd} place winner was Voiture 460. The reports totaled \$431,676.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities Norman Gentry received 7 reports with 79 events shown. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 333, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 1541, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 1292.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training, Clarence Buckley, stated 13 Voitures sent in a report and \$80,500 was expended. There are 138 Nurses in Training. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 460, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 3, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 1395.

Grand Aumonier Marvin Harper asked for the names of deceased members for the memorial service.

Grand Directeur Publiciste William Hilker could not be here so Terry Lanning gave his report. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 1403, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 760.

Grand Directeur Americanism, Sam Guenther, stated he received 5 reports. The total of the Americanism Consolidate Report and the Annual Local Voiture Membership Report was \$256,671 or \$470.96 per member. For the large Voitures the $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 38. For the medium Voitures the $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 760 and $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 460, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 1541. For the small Voitures the $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 1403. Three Voitures reported giving out 1,370 flags for first graders.

Grand Directeur Carville Star Leon Hill gave out his awards. Received 6 reports. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 1541 and $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 333, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 448.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA Dave Diaz could not be here so John Partin gave his report. He received 10 reports. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 1379, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 1541, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 460.

Grand Directeur Ritual John Partin stated that he received 10 reports. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 333, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 448, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 1321.

Grand Directeur Special Awards David Brazie could not be here so Terry Lanning gave his report. The Law and Order winner was Mark DeGraffenreid and the City of the Year was Sedalia. $1^{\rm st}$ place goes to Voiture 333.

Grand VAVS Chairman Chip Berkley said 8 reports were received for a total of \$150,000. The $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 448, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 1541, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 333.

Grand Directeur Youth Sports, David Voyles announced the $1^{\rm st}$ place winner was Voiture 1321, $2^{\rm nd}$ place winner was Voiture 460, and $3^{\rm rd}$ place winner was Voiture 760. There was \$137,437 spent in Youth Sports.

Sous Correspondant, Grant Willis, said to send him any articles and flyers to be put in the Grand Newsletter. The next issue will be early August.

Time & Place Committee, Rich Heigert, reported that the Fall Grand Cheminot & Homecoming on October 1 to 3, 2010, will be held at the Truman Hotel in Jefferson City. The Spring Wreck and Cheminot will be in Festus at the Best Western on April 8 to 10, 2011. The Grande Promenade will be June 24 to 26, 2011 would also be at Festus Best Western. The Fall Grand Cheminot and Homecoming will be September 30 to October 2, 2011 at the Festus Best Western. Going to the Best Western is subject to an inspection by the committee.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno and Terry Lanning spoke on the Central States Promenade. It will be held in Missouri at the Embassy Suites by the airport on April 28 to May 1, 2011. Friday there was a meeting on the Central States.

Old Business - Rich Heigert said the National Past Chef de Gare Club membership year is now from October 1 to September 30. The 2011 dues are now due.

New Business - Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning said he went to Department Headquarters and went through a number of old items which were mainly from John Newberry, Chef de Chemin de Fer 1953. Discussed these items with the Department Adjutant Frank Prosser and we agreed that a Newberry trophy case can be put on the first floor of Department HQ and we can put some

of Newberry's items as well as other 40/8 items in it. We can also put the pictures of past Grand Chef de Gare's on the wall of the basement conference room. Larry Ebersold will see about doing both of these items. Terry also took a Nurses Training trophy that has not been issued to anyone yet. It is a National Nurses Training trophy in Newberry's name. Terry will talk to the National Correspondant.

Under Good Of The Voiture, Ray Money is in a nursing home and is in a wheelchair so everyone should try to send him a card. Ray Brodzinski said Grants Farm will not let Voiture 38 use Grants Farm for their children's party. Don Fligge reported on Truman Day. Don said it was all messed up this year. They did not properly recognize our National Officer. Robert Fletcher asked if any other Legion Posts sponsored the naturalization program.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno closed the Grand Cheminot in the proper manner at $3:23\ \mathrm{PM}.$
