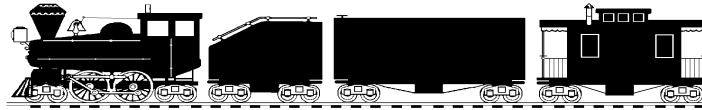

GRANDE PROMENADE, JULY 1, 2012  
TRUMAN Hotel, Jefferson City, Missouri

Grand Chef de Gare, David Christian, opened the Grande Promenade at 9:00 AM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier, John Paul Kopp.

Roll call of officers showed a few more excused, a few more absent, and the rest claimed to be here, fines were everywhere. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed there were eleven present. Roll call of Voitures showed there was a quorum present. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 520, 966, 1395 and 1402. Rich Heigert gave the Rules of Procedure. Notion offered by Rich Heigert, seconded by Art Wilson, that the Rules of Procedure be followed...passed.

Grand Chef de Gare Christian introduced the distinguished guests; American Legion National Vice Commander David Voyles, said to keep fighting for the vets. Also introduced were NEC Richard Heigert and Alt. NEC Charley Goodin.

Notion offered by Art Wilson, second by John Kopp, that the minutes of the June 26, 2011 Grande Promenade be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Historien Michael Brueckmann presented First place award to Voiture 1541 for their yearbook.

Grand Chef Christian called on the Grande Promenade Committees starting with the Audit Committee chaired by Rich Heigert with the help of Sam Guenther and Leon Hill. Also present were Grand Commissaire Intendant Ralph Turner and Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning. Rich stated that the Audit took place on June 30, 2012 at the Truman Hotel at 9:00 AM. The Committee reviewed all deposits and disbursements and validated the Financial Report of June 30, 2012. The Grande began the year with \$2,783.76 and had deposits totaling \$7,738.58. Expenses totaled \$7,090.92 leaving a final balance of \$3,431.42, for a surplus of \$647.66. The Money Market account reflected a balance of \$1,071.81, plus 4 CD's. The total assets of the Grand as of June 30, 2012 are \$25,503.23. The committee also recommends that due to the low rate of interest that all Savings Certificates be renewed for 1 year. The committee thanked Grand Commissaire Intendant Ralph Turner for the job he did and for being very neat. Notion offered by Rich, seconded by Art Wilson, to approve the Audit Committee Report and the finance report as presented...passed.

Grand Chef Christian called on the Resolutions Committee chaired by Grant Willis. Grant reported that he opened the committee at 9:00AM in the lobby. Grant stated he had resolutions for Ed Jones for Grand Chef de Gare, Ralph Turner for Grand Chef de Train, Leon Hill for Grand Commissaire Intendant, Terry L. Lanning for Grand Correspondant, and Terry L. Lanning for National Commissaire Intendant. The committee approved these resolutions. It is the recommendation of the committee that the first four resolutions be read by the Grand Correspondant during the election of officer's and voted on by the floor for a favorable vote. Grant offered a notion for the approval of the resolution for Terry Lanning for National Commissaire Intendant, seconded by George Ridley...passed. The committee adjourned at 9:10am. Grant offered a notion for the Resolutions Committees report to be accepted, seconded by George Ridley ...passed.

Grand Chef Christian called on the Chairman of the Credential Committee, Ed Jones. Ed gave the voting strength for each Voitures and the overall for the Grand Voiture (65) and Ed offered a notion, second by Virgil Morice, that the report be accepted as given...passed.

Grand Chef Christian called on the Constitution Committee chaired by Robert Phillips. Robert reported that last year's changes to the Grande Constitution were approved by Nationale except for Article II Section 3. Nationale wanted to take out "this Grande Voiture" and insert "the Voiture Locale". He opened the committee at 9:20AM in the hotel lobby. The committee recommends making the change that Nationale suggested. Robert offered a notion, second by George Ridley, that the report is accepted as well as the change to the Constitution as given...passed unanimously.

New Business - Art offered a notion to take the Department Commander Goff and Rich Heigert's fines at the banquet which total \$41 and add \$9 from fine money for \$50.00 and send that to the sponsor a hole at the golf tournament. Seconded George... passed.

Grand Chef Christian called on the Chairman of the Nominating Committee, Chubbs Buckley. Chubbs reported that the meeting was held at the Truman Hotel and started at 9:00 AM. There were a number of voyageurs in attendance. The Nominating Committee recommends to the Grande these elected officers. Chubbs read the recommendation of the Committee for elective officers for 2012-2013.

Grand Chef Christian relieved the members of the Grande Promenade Committees.

Newly elected Edward R. Jones gave a short speech. He thanked everyone and especially Voiture 1379 for their help.

Larry Ebersold turned over Junior Doc Buzzard to David Christian to take care of while he is Grand Chef de Gare Passe. Gary Reno said a fine was in order because Doc Buzzard did not remove his chapeau.

The Promenade was recessed at 10:05 AM to let the families and friends in for the Memorial Service and installation of officers.

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare David Christian, opened the Grand Cheminot a little late at 1:05 PM (and he paid for it) with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier John Paul Kopp.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest were rowdy. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that thirteen answered.

Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 520, 966, 1395 and 1402.

Sous Directeur Special Awards (Law & Order) Norm Gentry introduced the Grande Law & Order winner, Alexander Vivas. He is with the State Highway Patrol. Patrolman Vivas said a few words and left.

Grand Chef de Gare Christian introduced the distinguished guests; American Legion National Vice Commander David Voyles, had some nice words to say. Also introduced was NEC Richard Heigert and Alt. NEC Charley Goodin, but they said very little.

Art Wilson presented Bull Grand Chef de Train to Grand Chef de Train Ed Jones. Art said he found him in the pasture doing what bulls do. Then Grand Chef de Train Ed Jones was fined \$20.00 because Bull Grand Chef de Train did not have his membership card or a chapeau on. Ed reluctantly paid his fine.

Rich Heigert said we will follow Robert's Rules Order. Notion offered by Rich Heigert, seconded by George Ridley, that the Grand Spring Cheminot minutes be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning told everyone that several Voitures have not sent in their list of Officers and Directeurs. He needs this soon so he can update the mailing list. Terry also read an article that was in the Sedalia Democrat newspaper about Voiture 333 donating four flags for the Pettis County Courthouse.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Ralph Turner, reported that the finance report was passed out and discussed it. After the audit report the finance report will be acted on.

Grand Chef de Train, Ed Jones, reported on the Grande membership. The Grande has 1,167 members, 90.6% of quota. The Grande is ranked 18<sup>th</sup> in Nationale. Ed asked the Sous Chef de Trains to report to which John Kopp and Dave Bexten reported on the Voitures they were assigned.

Grand Cheminot reports were given by Voiture 3, 38, 130, 292, 333, 448, 460, 760, 1292, 1321, 1379, and 1541. The highlights are - Voiture 3 in May had their Annual Memorial Service, participated in the Salvation Army's bell ringing program and raised \$2,500, they spent over \$20,000 for nurses in training, had a nurses training dinner, gave \$750 to the Permanent Memorial Day Committee, sponsored 8 boys to Boys State; Voiture 38 participated in the Veterans Day Parade, held a xmas party for 350 kids, loco was in the Thanksgiving parade, and participated in the June naturalization ceremony; Voiture 130 have 12 nurses in training, they had a fundraiser and made \$1,600; Voiture 292 spent \$7,500 for nurses in training, spent \$3,000 for child welfare, spent \$4,500 for veterans and have bingo's; Voiture 333 spent \$1,000 for nurses in training, gave 305 flags to First Graders, will be involved in a fishing tournament for children, for Memorial Day assisted in placing flags on 2,000 graves and services, retired 401 flags, raised \$1,480 at their annual picnic, daily they unfurl 100 flags around the Pettis County court house, have 25 members on active duty; Voiture 448 participated in the Veterans Day parade, has xmas and Easter for kids, had a fundraising BBQ, and participated in Welcome Home Troops; Voiture 460 spent \$14,983 to assist child welfare on such things as Christmas for needy kids, utility deposits, 3 boys to Boys State and the St. Nicks benefit, they have 20 nurses in training, sponsored youth teams for \$5,503, and donated \$10,505 for homeless veterans, Salvation Army's Tree of Lights, and St. James Veterans Home Christmas fund; Voiture 760 supported \$500 for Veterans Home, supported girls volleyball team, \$1,600 for boys to boys state, and kids Christmas party; Voiture 1292 has 2 nurses, a Christmas party for special kids, a spring BBQ, one boy to boys state, helps at Truman Hospital, currently have a raffle going on; Voiture 1321 has 5 nurses, 1 boy to boys state, and have their cooker our once per month; Voiture 1379 are planning for their annual Chic Nic at Wallace State Park on August

25, 2012 at 1:00pm, held a welcome home for Voyageur Lisa Gains from Afghanistan; Voiture 1403 sold ribs to go, ran mouse races, they have a small loco, 3 nurses in training, donated \$1,400 to Truman VA Hospital, participated in numerous Legion Post Honor Guard services; Voiture 1541 is having their car show on August 18, 2012, wrecked 3 PGs, held Calvin Kane ceremony, posted colors in the St. Charles Memorial Day observances, installation of Officers will be August 11, 2012 at Wentzville American Legion Post, and sponsored 1 boy to Boys State.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Hallie Williams, presented 1<sup>st</sup> place to Voiture 448, 2<sup>nd</sup> place to Voiture 460, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place to Voiture 1321.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities George Ridley said he received 9 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 460, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 1403, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 1541.

Sous Grand Directeur Nurses Training Chris Bryson said he received 11 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 460, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place was a tie to Voiture 130 and 292. There was \$33,500 spent.

Grand Aumonier John Paul Kopp says he needs a list of deceased voyageurs for the Grand Promenade Memorial Service.

Grand Directeur Publiciste Charles Goodin, he received 8 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 333, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 1379, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 460.

Grand Conducteur John Kopp said he has collected \$116 in fines so far because nobody knows how to speak correctly.

Grand Directeur Americanism Robert Emery said he received 8 Americanism reports and 6 Flags for 1<sup>st</sup> Graders for a total of \$271,000. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 1321, and 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 38.

Grand Directeur Box Car, Grant Willis said he received 8 reports. First place will get a new traveling trophy. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 448, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 1379, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 760.

Grand Directeur Carville Star Leon Hill. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 1541, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 448, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 460.

Grand Directeur Ritual Kevin Johnson received 8 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 130, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 4481, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 1321.

Grand Chairman VAVS Thomas Berkley said the reports show we traveled 21,145 miles and spent \$4,405. 1<sup>st</sup> place is Voiture 292, 2<sup>nd</sup> place is Voiture 460, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place is Voiture 333.

Rich Heigert reported on MAVO and said the Grande 40/8 was accepted into MAVO. The state Veterans Commission will now get the entire \$2.00 casino fee.

Sous Correspondant, Grant Willis, said to send him any articles for the Grand Newsletter. The next issue will be early August.

Time & Place Committee, Art Wilson reported that the Fall Grand Cheminot & Homecoming (September 28-30, 2012) will be in Jefferson City, Truman Hotel.

The Spring Wreck will be at the Ramada Inn in Springfield.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Committee Chairman Ray Brodzinski stated there weren't any nominees.

New Business - none

Under Good Of The Voiture -National Legion Vice Commander Dave Voyles has 9 Departments; he said the Department of Defense will have some big cuts, Tricare costs are going up. We have to fight for vets, especially the young ones. Charlie Goodin asked the Grande to sponsor a golf hole for \$50. Art offered a notion to make it \$100 and to take it out of the fine money with the balance of the fine money going to the Missouri POW/MIA Scholarship fund, seconded by John Kopp... passed.



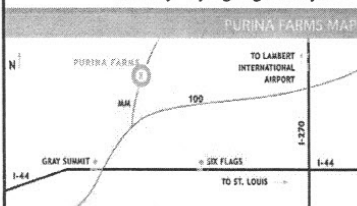
