#### GRAND CHEMINOT, JUNE 22, 2019 Holiday Inn, Earth City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Calvin Bumgarner, opened the Grand Cheminot at 1:00 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a prayer by Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan.

Roll call of officers showed some were there. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that thirteen answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that there was a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call so they paid a fine. Absent was Voitures 966, 1395, 1402, and 1403. The Chef appointed Terry McDonald to be acting Grand Conducteur. Chef Bumgarner just got started when his phone rang and he paid for it as well as breaking colors while paying his fine. Not off to a good start. Chef Bumgarner had some very sad news in that Passe Grand Chef de Gare Grant Willis had suddenly passed away yesterday.

Sous Grand Avocat Rich Heigert said we will use the Grande Constitution and the Voiture Nationale Constitution and then Roberts Rules of Order. Rich offered such a notion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Voyles and passed.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson and seconded by Art Johnson, that the Grand Spring Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning said he passed around a sheet to sign up if you are going to Promenade Nationale. Terry also received some information from Special Olympics Missouri.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Frank Angelo, discussed the finance report.

Grand Chef de Train Janice Hartley said we are at 94% and called on the Sous Chef de Trains to report on their Voitures, to which Benjamin Sargent stated his Voitures were 12 short, Hallie William said his Voitures were 12 short, and Don Barbour said his Voitures were 14 short. The Grand has a total membership of 728, down 48 from last year. Notion to accept reports by Don Barbour, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ralph Turner and passed.

Terry Lanning stated Voiture 1395 only has 2 paid up for life members. Ben Sargent said he tried to contact John Doane's wife by phone and mail and no response to see if she knew if Voiture 1395 had a checking account. Terry Lanning offered a notion to drop Voiture 1395, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kevin Johnson. Discussion on what to do with the 2 PUFL's, Ben said one had passed away. It was decided that Voiture 460 would receive the other PUFL. (Later Terry Lanning found out that the other PUFL had also passed away recently.) Passed.

The highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 38 is 2 over, has 5 nurses in training, they had a memorial service, their Loco came to the Spring Wreck as well as Imperial for a fundraiser for a cancer victim, Loco went to St. Gabriel's School picnic parade, had to get a new furnace and air conditioner units, Mike Brueckmann has attended a couple of their Promenade's; Voiture 130 is selling towels and raised \$6,153, they spent \$7,700 for nurses training; Voiture 292 sent 2 boys to Boys State and 2 girls to Girls State, participated in Welcome Home Festival; Voiture 333 has 4 nurses in training, had one PG, attended a Crown Hill Cemetery program; Voiture 448 had a Christmas Party and Easter Party at Marygrove kids home, one of the Marygrove kids graduated from West Point, two others are in basic training, meeting at Post 338; Voiture 460 has a raffle going on to win gift cards, placed flags on veterans graves for Memorial Day, helped with Tornado relief supplies, participated in Flag Day Ceremony, has 7 Nurses in Training, will have a July 4<sup>th</sup> BBQ; Voiture 760 has 1 nurse in training, had a horseshoes and hand grenade fundraiser; Voiture 1292, had a BBQ fundraiser, had a golf tournament; Voiture 1321 has 2 nurses in training, cooker is out at Buchheits in Herculaneum on the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of the month they sell sandwiches, pork steaks, hamburgers, brats and hot dogs; Voiture 1379 will have their ChickNick on August 17, 2019 at American Legion Post 61, 2 nurses in training, are at 100%; Voiture 1541 had a Calvin Kane Memorial service and Salon 771 joined in it, submitted a history book, participated in numerous Memorial Services.

Grand Historien Robert Emery said he received one Voiture History book from Voiture 1541 and they won 1<sup>st</sup> place.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Terry McDonald received 7 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1321, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1292 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 1541. Received 100 pins, which were distributed to Voitures, which have all been paid for.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities Charles Kuehnel – Terry Lanning gave report presented awards 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1292, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1541 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 38.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley said spent \$48,450. Received 10 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 3, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 130 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 1292.

Grand Drapeau East C. J. New – him and Janice bought the banner frame cost \$125.99. Notion by Kevin to reimburse Janice for cost, 2<sup>nd</sup> Barnes, passed.

Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan said to let her know if any Voitures have any deceased for the Memorial Ceremony.

Sous Grand Conducteur Terry McDonald said the Spring Wreck was a success.

Grand Directeur Americanism Robert Emery received 8 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 448 and received the trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1541 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 333.

Grand Directeur Box Car Joel Doyscher could not be here but sent in the awards. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1541 and received the trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1379 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 460.

Grand Directeur Carville Star Mike Scruby said he received 7 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 448, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1379 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 1321.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA A. J. Noonan – said 7 reports were received and all pins have been paid for.  $1^{st}$  place went to 333,  $2^{nd}$  place went to 1321 and  $3^{rd}$  place went to 1541.

Grand Directeur Ritual Kevin Johnson said he received 7 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1321, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 38 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 448.

Grand Directeur Special Awards Hallie Williams – 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1541 for Law Officer of the Year Terri Mancusi and 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1321 for Hero of the Year Michael Warden.

Grand VAVS Chairman Tom Goodin could not be here so Terry Lanning gave the report. Received 5 reports. 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 1292, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1541 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 448.

Grand Directeur Youth Sports Ann Puck said 1<sup>st</sup> place went to 448, 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to 1321 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place went to 1541.

Grand Sous Correspondant, Terry Lanning said with the passing of Grant Willis then next year Robert Emery will be taking over this job. The Grand Chef and any other articles are due to Robert by the end of the month. If anyone else has anything to put in the Grande Newsletter then send it to Robert. If a voyageur wants the newsletter then send Robert their email address and he will email the newsletter to them. The next newsletter will go out August 1<sup>st</sup>. If a voyageur changes their email address then let Robert and Terry Lanning know.

Time and Place Committee Art Wilson said we will be here for the Homecoming October 4 to 6, 2019. For 2020 we will be at the Oasis Hotel and in 2021 at Four Point Hotel in north Kansas City.

Distinguished Voyageur Bob Phillips said no applications were received this year, but they are out there, so turn them in.

MAVO Calvin Bumgarner went to the last meeting. The lady running it was doing a great job. The Veterans Homes are finding a hard time in getting nurses. They hope to raise the salary.

Promenade Nationale Representative Rich Heigert said there was a meeting last night. The contact with Voiture Nationale has been signed and is working on the hotel contracts. Will need everyone's help.

Old Business - none

New Business – Dave Bexten said the tornado they had in Jefferson City damaged the Special Olympics Missouri building. There is \$409 in last year fine money that has not been earmarked. Chip offered a notion to pay the \$409 plus the fine money for the Grand Promenade weekend to the Special Olympics Missouri, seconded Barnes and passed. Terry Lanning brought up that the Grande always provides a \$50 gift to the Sous Correspondant but with Grant passing away then how do we want to handle it. Notion made by Chip to pay the money to Grants wife Shirley, se-conded and passed.

Good of the Grande Voiture – Past Grand Chef breakfast, meet in lobby at 7:00am. Art said we need to get the Grande flags to the Hutchens Funeral Home for Grant's funeral, C. J. > GRAND PROMENADE, June 23, 2019 Holiday Inn Hotel, Earth City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Calvin Bumgarner, opened the Grand Promenade sharply at 9:00 AM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest were sleeping. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed 11 answering. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed there was a quorum. Absent was Voitures 3, 966, 1395, 1402, and 1403.

Sous Grand Avocat Rich Heigert said we will use the Grande and Voiture Nationale's Constitution and then Roberts Rules of Order. Ann Puck offered a notion to accept report, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Voyles passed.

Notion offered by Art Wilson, seconded by Bob Phillips, that the minutes of the June 24, 2018 Grande Promenade be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Chef Bumgarner called on the Grande Promenade Committees starting with the Audit Committee chaired by Terry McDonald with the help of Robert Emery and David Christian. Also present were Grand Commissaire Intendant Frank Angelo, and Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning. Terry McDonald stated the audit took place on June 22, 2019 at the Holiday Inn Clark Room at 9:00 AM. The Committee reconciled the financial ledger with the bank statements and all outstanding checks. The Grande began the year with \$1,398.63 and had deposits totaling \$8,050.99. Disbursements totaled \$6,822.85 leaving a final balance of \$2,626.77. The Grande Voiture has two one year CD's, #721 for \$4,000 and #722 for \$4,000, both earning 1.25%. The Stifel-Nicolaus investment portfolio's value is \$9,057.10. Dividends are being paid at an average of 3.3%. The Audit Committee recommends the Grande keep this investment another year. Grande has total assets of \$19,626.17. The committee recommends that the Grand transfer \$1,000 from one of the CD's to the checking account. The Audit Committee wishes to congratulate the Commissaire Intendant Frank Angelo and Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning for the excellent condition of the financial records. The Chairman wishes to thank David Christian and Robert Emery for their assistance. Notion offered by Terry McDonald, seconded by Dave Christian, to approve the Audit Committee Report and the finance report as presented...passed.

Grand Chef Bumgarner called on the Resolutions Committee chaired by Art Wilson. Art reported that he opened the committee at 9:00 AM with 11 present. Art stated he had resolutions for Janice Harley for Grand Chef de Gare, Frank Angelo for Grand Chef de Train, Robert Emery for Grand Commissaire Intendant, and Terry L. Lanning for Grand Correspondant. Committee recommended these be approved and passed on to the Nomination Committee for action. Art offered a notion to approve the Committees recommendations on these resolutions, seconded by Voyles...passed. There was a resolution from Grande du Georgia stating they wanted to make the National Avocat and the National Correspondant non-voting members of the Committee on Committees. Committee recommended that this resolution be brought to the floor for discussion

and action. After discussion on the Committee on Committees resolution Barnes offered a notion to not approve the Georgia resolution, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kevin Johnson...passed. Art offered a notion to approve his report, seconded by Ralph Turner...passed.

Grand Chef Bumgarner called on the Chairman of the Credentials Committee, Janice Hartley gave the voting strength for each Voiture plus Grand Chefs de Gare Passe present. Janice offered a notion, seconded by Kevin Johnson, that the report be accepted as given...passed.

Grand Chef Bumgarner called on the Constitution Committee chaired by Robert Phillips. Committee opened at 9:15 AM with 9 voyageurs present representing 7 Voitures. Robert reported there was nothing to discuss regarding changes or amendments pertaining to the Constitution. Robert offered a notion to accept his report, seconded by Don Barbour...passed.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Ralph Turner said there were no applications so let's get some in next year.

New Business –. Grand Chef Bumgarner called on the Chairman of the Nominating Committee, Kevin Johnson. Kevin reported that the meeting was held at the Holiday Inn Hotel on June 22, 2019.

Four resolutions were given to the committee and made available for those present at the meeting to read. After a very short discussion in was agreed the following recommendations would be presented to the Grand Promenade. Kevin read the recommendation of the Committee for elective officers for 2019-2020
