
On another note, I am from Vancouver, WA. and a US Navy Vietnam Veteran, the home of Harley Hall. Harley Hall 05/US Navy, pilot was shot down on the last day of the war and was the last Navy air casualty of the Vietnam War. He was the last American to be classified Prisoner of War in the Vietnam War.

Harley went to the same High School as I did, Evergreen High School. (11 years before I did) He joined the Navy in 1957. He continued on in his Navy career to become the youngest Navy Cmdr. at 32. He did two tours in Vietnam, before becoming the Commander of the Navy's elite precision flying team, The Blue Angels. On his third tour in Vietnam, Harley and his backs

seater were shot down, January 27, 1973; just ten hours before the cease-fire was signed. They safely ejected from their crippled jet and were visually followed to the ground by other flight members.

This is one of many stories, but is close to my heart as all are.


