Child Welfare

Sarah and her grandmother were shopping for Sarah's school clothing. It was not the happy anticipation of a pre-school sale. They were shopping for Sarah's next-day clothing the night of a house fire that took all of Sarah's possessions. A man previously unknown to Sarah waited at the cashier's stand with up to \$300 toward her bedding and clothing. If there were other children, there would be up to \$1,000 per family. Who does that? You do. That man, representing a 40&8 Voiture Locale, will receive reimbursement from the 40&8's Ardery Trust for the money spent that night.

Child Welfare is the oldest 40&8 program. At its 1923 inception, beneficiaries were children whose fathers did not return from

WWI or whose fathers returned with wounds that limited the family's income. There were no governmental programs to assist those children. In 1925, 40&8 Voyageurs established the Child Welfare Fund, the foundation of the Charles Ardery Child Welfare Trust. That Trust has expanded to aid children regardless of veterans' connection.

The Trust obtains its funds from \$.25 of your annual dues, donations and sale of pins, mostly to 40&8 Voyageurs. Take pride in the Missouri Voitures Locales that purchased pins to support the Child Welfare program. Wear your own pin proudly, knowing you helped Sarah and other victims of fires, floods, tornadoes, or other disasters.

POW/MIA

The 40/8 Nationale POW/MIA Program raises funds in Honor of the Servicemen & Women who were Prisoners of War, or are considered Missing in Action while serving in the defense of the United States of America, or its allies during times of armed conflict. The funds raised facilitate the formation and continuance of the Scholarship Trust Fund for direct descendants POW/MIA Servicemen and Women. Scholarships are limited to the Veteran, the Spouse of the Veterans, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren of the Veteran.

FALL GRAND CHEMINOT, November 10, 2018
OASIS HOTEL, SPRINGFIELD, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Calvin Bumgarner, opened the Fall Grand Cheminot at 1:00 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan.

Roll call of officers showed some were there. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that eleven answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent were Voitures 966, 1292, 1395 1402 and 1403.

Grand Avocat Grant Willis said we will follow Roberts Rules of Order. At this time Grand Chef de Gare Bumgarner's cell phone went off and he paid dearly.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by A J Noonan, that the Grand Promenade and Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning gave the minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting, held on November 10, 2018 at 9:00am. The budget was read by Frank Angelo. Frank Angelo offered a notion to accept the budget as printed, seconded by Ed Jones ... passed. Discussed what fundraiser we should have at the Spring Wreck. Decided to do the jockey stick horse race but with no betting, with Bob Phillips in charge. If a Voiture does not participate then there will be a \$50 fine and \$50 for participating. It was decided that the Grande should invite the Chef de Chemin de Fer Rick Williams to the Grande Spring Wreck and Cheminot. Rich Heigert offered a notion to authorize and set up a not for profit Corporation to run the 102nd Promenade Nationale, La Societe des 40 Hommes et 8 Chevaux. This Corporation would be owned by the Grande du Missouri with the Officers, Directors, and Incorporators being Richard Heigert President, Thomas Berkley Vice President, Terry McDonald Treasurer, Terry Lanning Secretary, and Leslie Willis Conducteur Nationale. The Grande would lend the 102nd Corporation \$500 for start up money. Any money made from the 102nd Promenade Nationale would go to the Grande. Seconded by Janice and passed. Terry will ask Department Judge Advocate Cassie Strom to set up the Corporation.

In July 2018 the Executive Committee approved a Promenade Nationale Committee consisting of Rich Heigert Chairman, with Terry McDonald, Bob Emery and Kevin Johnson. Grand Chef de Gare Bumgarner will disband this committee. Closed the Executive Committee meeting at 9:40am. Notion by Kevin Johnson to approve the minutes seconded by Ben Sargent and passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated the new yearbooks are in the back of the room. Terry emailed each Grand Directeur a listing of voyageurs from each Voiture that were on the various programs. Terry also read a letter from Special Olympics Missouri for the Grande's donation. Terry received an email from Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer James Coe, who is assigned Missouri, discussing membership. In the yearbook Mike Scruby's zip code should be 64068.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Frank Angelo, stated the finance report and budget were passed out and discussed them. Notion offered by Frank Angelo, second by Kevin Johnson, to accept the Finance report...passed.

Grand Chef de Train Janice Hartley said we are at 65.34%. She attended the Promenade Nationale in Louisville and went to the Resolution, Credentials, and Box Car Committee meetings. Voiture 1541 won first place for their history book (4th time in a row). There were two appoints to Nationale, Janice for Sous Box Car Directeur and Grant Willis for Sous Public Relations. She called on the Sous Chef de Trains to report on their Voitures, to which Ben Sargent said his area was at 65%. Ben also reported that two members who were running Voiture 1395 had passed away and he contacted some members of Voiture 1395 to see if they wanted to transfer and they did not want to and they did not know if their Voiture had any money left. Ben will send Carolyn Doane a letter to see if she knows about a bank account for Voiture 1395 that John Doane handled. Joel Doyscher said his area was at 63%, and Don Barbour said his area was at 67%. The Grand has a total membership of 487, plus some additions that were reported we will be at 68%. Grand Chef de Gare Bumgarner said we need to let the voyageurs know how important they are.

Cheminot Nationale Chip Berkley reported on the Nationale Promenade. There was a good turnout from the Grande. It was approved to raise Nationale dues by \$5.00 but this is not effective until the 2020 membership year, next summer. The password did not change. Kevin attended the Ritual meeting and they are going to change the form online. The Time and Place Committee assigned the Promenade Nationale to Missouri for 2021. Ed Jones attended the Historian meeting and said if any Voiture has newspaper coverage then send that to Angie. Ed also attended the Special Awards which received 9 nominations.

The next Promenade Nationale's will be in Myrtle Beach September 10-14, 2019 and Sandusky Ohio September 16-19, 2020

Some of the highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 38 have had their loco out and it will be available for the Spring Wreck if wanted, they had a theft of their air conditioner and have put a new one inside the garage; Voiture 130 is still selling towels and trash bags to raise money for their nurses in training but it is getting harder to get the towels; Voiture 292 had hot dogs and Brats at VA Hospital, they welcomed back the Honor Flight, donated \$1,000 to VA, attended some funerals, and rode with the Patriot Guard; Voiture 333 had a rededication of the Box Car at the State Fair, they had bingo at VA and did Flags to First Graders; Voiture 448 had a BBQ in June, will have their xmas party at Marygrove on 12/2/18; Voiture 460 helped out a prior nurse, had a BBQ, and had a Veterans Day meal; Voiture 760 had hot dogs and hand grenades and did good, they have one nurse in training; Voiture 1321 had their last cookout and have one nurse in training; Voiture 1379 had their Chick Nic and has one nurse in training; Voiture 1541 history book won 1st Place at Nationale, had their installation to which Passe Grand Chef de Gare Leon Hill did the installing, Christmas party will be 12/12/2018.

Grand Avocat Grant Willis said Voitures 333, 292, and 1379 had turned in new Constitutions and are awaiting Voiture Nationale approval. There are still a few Voitures that need to update their Constitution.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Terry McDonald said he has new 2019 pins if anyone wanted any let him know. Everyone should keep track of their time and miles that they do and report them.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley said he sent in a Boland Trust nurses training scholarship application for Voiture 1379 and is waiting on the approval.

Grand Directeur Americanism Bob Emery said he had new pins if anyone wanted any pins to let him know.

Grand Directeur Box Car Ernie Parker said he has 2019 pins so let him know if you need any.

Grand Directeur Carville Star Mike Scruby said he has 2019 pins so let him know if you need any.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA A. J. Noonan said he has new 2019 pins if anyone wanted any let him know.

Grand Directeur Ritual Kevin Johnson said he did not have any pins. Let the Conducteur know if you are bringing any PG's to the Spring Wreck.

Grand Directeur Youth Sports Ann Roberts said she has the 2019 pins so let her know if you want any. Nationale is creating a new form to ask for funds.

Grand Sous Correspondant Grant Willis said the Grand Chef is so far sending in his articles on time. Missouri was Honorable mention on the non advertising Newsletter.

Time and Place Committee Committeeman Kevin Johnson said we will be back to the Oasis Hotel in Springfield for 2020. The cost of the room will be \$99 plus tax. The dates will be April 17 - 19, 2020, June 19 - 21, 2020 and October 30 - November 1, 2020.

MAVO - Rich Heigert said the VA home in St. Louis will have \$19 million in renovations, where they are changing the 2 people per room to single rooms. The next MAVO meeting will be the 1st Monday in January 2019.

Grand Chef de Gare Bumgarner disbanded the Promenade Nationale Committee.

Old Business - none

New Business - Terry thanked everyone that helped in going through the old Grande records at Department Headquarter. Voiture 333 said on November 11, 2018 they are having a WWII speaker. 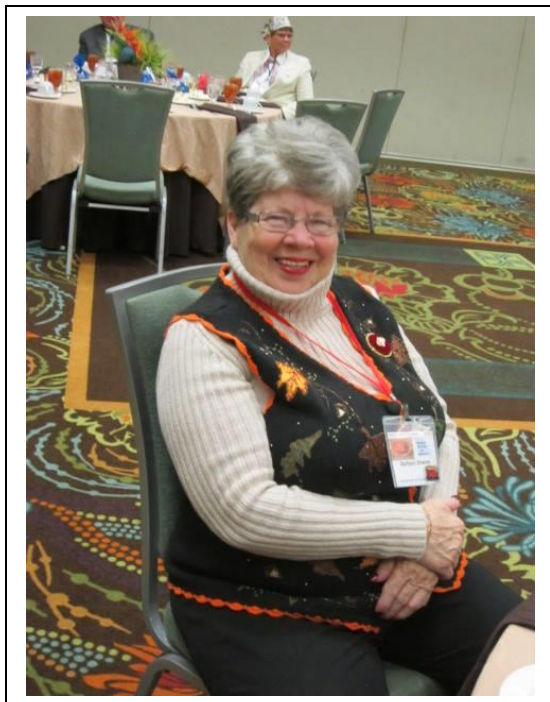
