If you have an event you would like


for me to attend or even a monthly Promenade, just contact me. If you need any help, I am here to serve you. Please share this with everyone.

SPRING WRECK DERBY

The Grande is once again going to have a fundraiser at the Spring Grande Cheminot & Wreck.

Each Voiture that is represented at the banquet will have a Jockey and one decorated Stick (Hobby) Horse entry. The more realistic the better, Owners of the horse wear your silks (colors) Each Voiture will decorate their Stick horse and select their own Jockey to ride in the Stick Horse Derby Parade. There will be a \$50.00 per Voiture entry fee. If a Voiture does not participate in the Derby there will be a \$50.00 fine. At the banquet the men or women, dressed as Jockeys with their Stick Horses, will go around the audience to collect money to be used to feed the horses. Make sure your Horse has a full belly or you may find your Jockey and Stick Horse at the bar instead of the starting gate. The Jockey who collected the most money will win a prize. Next, the Jockey and Stick Horse will run 2 races. The races will be 10 (1 foot) squares and each Jockey representative will roll a die and the Jockey will move that many squares. Be careful, if your Horse number comes up you lose that turn. There will not be any betting.

Stick Horses will be available for \$10 on Saturday or you can bring your own. If you want to buy one then let Bob Phillips know you will need one. Remember you will need to decorate the Horse. Please plan on joining fellow Voyageurs at the Spring Wreck, Stick Horse Decorating and Racing Contest. Brush off your STETSON; polish your Boots and join in on the fun.

YOUTH SPORTS

Financial assistance is available to help with Youth Sports from the Nationale committee. Applications for grants from the Nationale Youth Sports committee may be made for the purpose of providing financial assistance to a deserving and needy youth athlete or team to participate in sports. Applications must be made on forms supplied by the Nationale Committee. The Voiture Locale and Grand Voiture must approve the request and forward it to the Nationale Youth Sports Directeur. The Locale or Grand Voiture must put up matching funds to be eligible for assistance, unless they can demonstrate they don't have funds. We suggest that requests for reimbursement not total in excess of \$200.00 per each Locale Voiture and not more than a total of \$1,000.00 per Grand Voiture during the year. This can be modified in the future after a history has been established. Consideration will be given to emergency claims.

Please let me know if your Voiture would like to see assistance in sponsoring Youth to play in sports and you have met the requirements listed above.



Legislative Agenda - 2019

- Maintain the 9-person Missouri Veterans Commission with 1 Ex-Officio member from the MMPEC AS STATED IN Chapter 42 RsMO and maintain the governance of Missouri Veterans Commission as stated in Chapter 42 RsMO with NO MERGER WITH ANY OTHER ENTITY; MVC shall remain under the Department of Public Safety
- Maintain the necessary level of funding for the operation and maintenance of State Veterans Homes, State Veterans Cemeteries, Veterans Service Officers Program, Veterans Grant Program and other needs of Missouri Veterans;
- Support the execution of the Missouri Veterans Commission Capital Improvement Budget including construction of new Columbarium Walls at Bloomfield and Jacksonville Veterans Cemeteries
- Conduct feasibility study of veterans needs in our state to include Adult Day Health Care;
- Support implementation of new VA Home model in all of our state veterans homes to include construction of private rooms and restrooms for our veterans
- Urge the Missouri legislature to license privately-funded medical marijuana production operations to enable safe and efficient cannabis drug development research and distribution and establish an education program to enhance the knowledge of the public;
- Support the creation of a state-wide Prescription Drug Monitoring program;
- Support the concept of the "Missouri Veterans' Heritage Protection Act" to protect memorials of historic military significance in Missouri;
- Urge public recognition of the University of Missouri Veterans Clinic and provide appropriate budget consideration;
- Support any other legislation introduced in the legislature determined by the MAVO Legislative Committee to be in the interest of Veterans.

MEMORIAL DAY IN ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY



The Forty and Eight Memorial Day Ceremony is an annual event hosted by the 40 & 8 Memorial Day Committee. Planning for the weekend starts in October for the next year's Memorial Day Ceremony in Arlington National Cemetery. The Sunday evening banquet includes the Calvin Kain Memorial Service. Monday is a solemn occasion when we attend and participate in the National Memorial Day Ceremony at the Amphitheater in Arlington National Cemetery. At this event, Volture Nationale and Cabane Nationale Drapeaux are marched into the Amphitheater. After Memorial Day addresses are given by the President of the United States and the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the Chef de Chemin de Fer and La Presidente

Nationale are invited to present a wreath at the tomb of the Unknowns. This is the only time that the 40 & 8 and La Femme leaders are recognized publicly by the US Government.

In 2001 we started a tradition of giving a US Flag to everyone entering the amphitheater. Because this requires about 10,000 flags, the committee requests donations. If you can help, please send your contribution to the Committee (as shown on the registration form). All donors will be listed in the Program Book. This is truly a weekend to remember and it is OPEN to everyone who would like to attend. Because of limited space, we recommend you register early.

The weekend is largely financed by the Memorial Day Program Book, so even if you are unable to attend, please consider purchasing an ad or being a booster.
