Very Pleased to announce through the efforts of Congressman Clever, Senators McCaskill and Blunt a provision was an amendment to the FY 2015 Defense Bill which passed the House and then the Senate on Friday, December 12,2015 89-11. This bill names The Liberty Memorial in Kansas City as the National World War I Memorial and Museum and creates Pershing Park in Washington, D.C. as a National WWI Memorial.
