Greetings Voyageurs,

As 2025 ends and 2026 begins I would like to extend a Happy New Year to all and hope that your Christmas Holiday season was enjoyable. I extend warm wishes to your families also. As this milestone passes, I will note that we are halfway through our membership year and would like to share our membership statistics. As of December 11, 2025, Grande Du Missouri is at 65.60% and 205 short of quota. The individual region Sou Chef statistics show

Hallie Wiliams (V38, 448, 966 and 154) out front with 76.97% congrats to Mark Twain V966 for achieving 100% however V38 Spirit of ST. Louis is not far behind at 95.5%. Calvin Bumgarner (V3, 130, 1379 and 1402) achieved 66.10% with V130 Jesse James leading the way in that Region with 95%. Dan Levasseur with V292, 333,1292 and 1403 is close behind Calvin at 65.33%, V1403 Lake of the Ozarks only needs that 1 to hit the mark. Roger Wallenburg with V460, 760 and 1321 is at 51.97%. As we roll into 2026, I would ask the Chef De Gare's, Chef de Train's and all voyageurs to reach out to your current members at your Locale and get those renewals. We all know that many of our Voyageurs do not attend promenades regularly, however, a quick scrub of your non-renewals by the Chef De Train during Promenade will allow the Voyageurs present to know who has not renewed and possibly they can reach out to their fellow voyageurs about renewing.
