

MAVO

It's over. The first Regular Session of the 98 General Assembly of the State of Missouri concluded on Friday, 15 May 2015 with just a Technical Session later in the month and a Veto Session in September remaining on the agenda. On bills relating to veterans and/or military there were two Appropriation Bills passed which contained the budget for the Missouri Veterans Commission and also for the \$14.5 million dollars for maintenance of Missouri's Veteran Homes. There were five House Bills approved along with two House Concurrent Resolutions while on the Senate side there were four Senate Bills and one Senate Concurrent Resolution. However, if you look at the "Pending Legislation" that was not passed, you will find several bills that were added as amendments to the above legislation that did pass. The bill for \$50million dollars for a new Missouri Veterans Home (HJR 44) passed the House but with only three days left in the Session did not get very far in the Senate. Some of the approved bills may get Veto'ed by the Governor and, if so, will be considered for override during the Veto Session in early September.

Thank you and this will be my last weekly report, although I will send interim reports as the need justifies until the next session begins in January 2016.
