Fellow Voyageurs,


Here we are with only a couple of months to go before we start the new year for 40/8. We are still behind in membership for the year. Please try to get your numbers in if you are holding any of the renewals.

SPRING GRAND CHEMINOT, APRIL 2, 2017 RAMADA PLAZA HOTEL, SPRINGFIELD, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Chip Berkley, opened the Spring Grand Cheminot at 9:00 AM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier John Kopp.

Roll call of officers showed some were there. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passé showed that ten answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminot showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent was Voiture's 760, 966, 1395, and 1402.

Grand Chef de Gare Berkley recognized Alternate DEC Tom Goodin and Correspondant National Patrick Mobley.

Grand Avocat Rich Heigert said we will follow the Rules of Procedure. Notion offered by Art Wilson, seconded by Ralph Turner, that the Fall Grand Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated he received resolution from David Voyles for Grand Chef, Calvin Bumgarner for Grand Chef de Train, Janice Hartley for Grand Commissaire Intendant, Terry Lanning for Grand Correspondant and Terry Lanning for Commissaire Intendant National. Terry also stated he received flyer for Kenneth Lafleur for Chef de Chemin de Fer for 2017-2018. He also received notice from Terry Davis stating he was resigning from the position of Grand Drapeau East after the Spring Cheminot.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Calvin Bumgarner, stated the finance report was passed out and discussed. Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, second by Art Wilson, to accept the Finance report subject to audit...passed.

Grand Chef de Train David Voyles said we are at 87% and called on the Sous Chef de Trains to report on their Voiture's, to which A. J. Noonan, Mike Brueckmann, Mike Scruby, and Terry McDonald did. The Grand has a total membership of 826. This is 55 members less than at this time last year. Voiture's 3, 130, 966, 1321 and 1395 are at or over 100%, good job. Everyone needs to give a big push to get the rest of the unpaid in. Some of the highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 3 is at 100% and has 14 Nurses in Training; Voiture 38 their loco was at the Veterans Day Parade in St. Louis and Florissant, 300 Patch Center kids at their xmas party; Voiture 130 sells towels and trash bags to raise money for their nurses in training, they have paid since 1989 \$214,000 for nurses in training; Voiture 292 made donations for VA and Hospitals, Boys State, Girls State, and helped members in need; Voiture 333 reached their fundraising goal of \$20,000 for the Boxcar restoration, bought \$1,200 trophies, medals and plaques for Jr. ROTC, had Veterans Day activities in Sedalia and a parade, in December had children from a Youth Home at Promenade, planning Memorial Day activities with a picnic and 2 lunch fundraisers, maintains 60 flags in downtown Sedalia, presented 1000 flags to First Graders; Voiture 448 will have a BBQ on June 3, 2017 at Cabela's, had a xmas party at Marygrove, and will have a Easter Party on 4/9/2017, are meeting at the Elks in Manchester, and will have their installation on 7/29/17 at Post 397; Voiture 460 spent \$400 for child welfare, have 6 nurses in training; Voiture 760 1 nurse in training, spent \$1300 for a Woman's Shelter, \$1900 for Ozark Food Harvest, they have stopped their bingo's; Voiture 1292 will have a fundraiser BBQ, had a kids xmas party, have 4 nurses in training, they have new vests, on June 2, 2017 will be the 1st annual Dr. Tamara Hopkins Golf Tourney; Voiture 1321 are over 100% in membership, have 4 nurses in training, 1 boy in Boys State, cooker is out one weekend each month at Buchheits from March 25th until October; Voiture 1379 will have their ChickNick on 8/19/17; Voiture 1403 has 2 nurses in

training, will be selling ribs; Voiture 1541 will have their Car Show on 8/19/17, had their Night at the Races it went very good, have 2 new PG's, sponsored a baseball team for \$540.

Grand Historien Hallie Williams said to send him pictures of the Grand Chef. Grand Avocat Richard Heigert said he has approved new constitutions for the Grand, 448, 460, 1321, 1292 is working on and recently received 1379 and 333's.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Benjamin Sargent said he needs everyone to start thinking about their reports which are due by June 15, 2017.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley could not be here but sent his report in. Nurses Training throughout the state seems to be going good. He has had a lot of calls about pins, scholarships and questions about programs and what they are planning. 2

Grand Aumonier John Kopp said for everyone to remember that Palm Sunday and Easter are coming up. He needs a list of the Voiture deceased for the Grand Promenade. Grand Publiciste Bob Emery said to send items to him to put on the web. He has our web page on a new server.

Conducteur Tom Goodin wanted to recognize the three new Voyageurs that we wrecked yesterday.

Grand Directeur Americanism Bob Emery said he needs everyone to start thinking about their reports which are due by June 15, 2017.

Grand Directeur Box Car Janice Hartley said she sent out pins and cards to those that requested them. All pins and cards have either been paid for or returned to her. Grand Directeur POW/MIA Frank Angelo said he needs everyone to start thinking about their reports which are due by June 15, 2017.

Grand Directeur Ritual Kevin Johnson said he needs everyone to start thinking about their reports which are due by June 15, 2017. He also said to not forget about the Calvin Kane memorial service.

Grand Directeur Special Awards Richard Pack did not get any applications.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Chairman Grant Willis said he did not get any nominations. There should be some worthy candidates to nominate.

Distinguished Guest Committee Richard Heigert recognized Correspondant National Patrick Mobley, to which he said a few words of thanks for the invite and he enjoyed himself. We need to replace our deaths and a few more to turn our membership around. Central States Committee-Art Wilson stated we will be here in May 2018. Richard Heigert offered a notion for the Grande to advance Central States Promenade 2018 \$600 seconded by John Kopp and passed. Old Business - none

New Business – Chef de Gare Berkley made the following appointments for the Grand Promenade committee chairmen: Nominations Kevin Johnson, Resolutions Art Wilson, Credentials David Voyles, Constitution Bob Phillips, and Audit Rich Heigert with committeemen Terry McDonald and Janice Hartley. And he appointed Larry Alderson to fill the Grand Drapeau East spot. Notion to accept appointments by Kerry Boardman and seconded by Art Wilson... passed.

Richard Heigert said he has applications for National Past Chef de Gare Club; it is only \$15 to join.

Kevin Johnson offered a notion to earmark the PG's collection for Nurses Training, passed.

Grand Chef de Gare Berkley closed the Spring Grand Cheminot in the proper manner at 10:30 AM.
