Fellow Voyageurs,



VOITURE ACTIVITIES

Greetings Fellow Voyageurs,

I hope your activity planning for the current reporting year is well underway. The reporting year began on July 1, 2017 and concludes on June 30, 2018. If each Voyageur maintains a log of his or her activities throughout the reporting year and turns that log into their Local Voiture Activities Directeur or Correspondant at the end of the year, your Local Voiture Activities Report will be more accurate and complete. The National Directeur along with the Sous Directeur's of Voiture Activities plan to revise the reporting form and

Instructions. To have the information that will be necessary to complete the new report, I suggest the following be included in your activities log: the name of the activity, the date of the activity, the number of Voyageurs and Dames participating in the activity, the hours expended on the activity, monies spent on the activity, and the miles traveled in support of the activity. Note that this information should be logged for all activities with and without rolling stock. For those of you that are new to Voiture Activities reporting, any event involving Voyageurs is a reportable event. Some examples include: membership events, fund raisers for nurses training, a dinner honoring the nurses receiving scholarships, flags for first graders, youth sport activities, all celebrations honoring and remembering veterans,

Promenades for which a quorum of the Voiture is present, volunteer work performed by Voyageurs, observances and parades of Memorial Day, Veterans Day, Flag Day, and King Day, Rituals performed, parties held, assistance for Boy's State, nursing home visits, meals that accompany funerals, Cheminot, Grand events attended, and Grand events sponsored. With simple logging of events, all Voiture's should have plenty of activities to report. Let's make this year a well reported year.
