SPRING GRAND CHEMINOT, MARCH 24, 2019 HOLIDAY INN EARTH CITY, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Calvin Bumgarner, opened the Spring Grand Cheminot at 9:00 AM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance,

and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan.

Roll call of officers showed some were there. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that ten answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent was Voitures 3, 966, 1395 1402 and 1403.

Grand Chef de Gare Calvin Bumgarner acknowledged that our guest was Chef de Chemin de Fer Rick. Grand Chef Bumgarner paid a \$20 fine for Grand Wreck.

Grand Avocat Grant Willis said we will follow the basic rules in the Constitution and Roberts Rules of Order. Grant offered a notion to fine Terry Lanning because he did not leave the POW/MIA banner and alter cloth for the wreck. This was seconded by Philips. On the question Terry Lanning said since Grant was the Sous Correspondant and did not ask for the POW/MIA banner and alter cloth then he also should pay a fine. Notion passed.

Notion offered by Janice Hartley, seconded by George Ridley, that the Fall Grand Cheminot minutes be accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated there are envelopes for the Grand Directeurs in the front. He also received notice that Michael McGary and John Kaiserian are running for Chef de Chemin de Fer. He received information on the Memorial Day activities at Arlington National Cemetery. He received information for Chef de Chemin de Fer Rick Williams Homecoming on April 6, 2019 in Cleveland, TN. He read some of the changes at Voiture Nationale, Terry Sims is the permanent Correspondant National but will be working part time and will be in the office as needed. He received resolutions for Grand Chef de Gare for Janice Harley, Grand Commissaire Intendant for Bob Emery, Grand Chef de Train for Frank Angelo and Grand Correspondant for Terry Lanning.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning stated he sent out the new report forms to all of the Voiture Correspondants as well as the forms for next year's officers. Terry Lanning said all Local Programs reports have to be in by June 15, 2019 to the Grand Directeurs.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Frank Angelo, stated the finance report was passed out and discussed. Notion offered by Art Wilson, second by Bob Phillips, to accept the Finance report...passed.

Grand Chef de Train Janice Hartley said we are at 683 or 85%. She called on the Sous Chef de Trains to report on their Voitures, to which Ben Sargent said his area was at 86%. Ben also reported that two members who were running Voiture 1395 had passed away and he contacted some members of Voiture 1395 to see if they wanted to transfer and they did not want to. Terry Lanning asked Grant to give Ben, Carolyn Doane's phone number for him to call her and see if she knows anything about Voiture 1395 bank account. Joel Doyscher said his area was at 91%, and Don Barbour could not be here but sent in a report that said his area was at 86%. Grand Chef de Gare Bumgarner said we need to let the voyageurs know how important they are and to mentor them when they are new.

Some of the highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 38 had their loco out at the Grand wreck yesterday and at Veterans Day and at the Patch Center. They wrecked 2 plus 1 yesterday; Voiture 130 is still selling towels to raise money for their nurses in training but it is getting harder to get the towels; Voiture 292 made donations to 2 nursing homes and the VA hospital, cooked for VA patients on Veterans Day, have 2 boys to Boys State and 1 girl to Girls State, have 3 nurses in training; Voiture 333 is going to do 1500 Flags to First Graders, want to build a glass case around the Box Car, they maintain 50 flags downtown; Voiture 448 had their xmas party for kids at Marygrove in December 2018 and will have an Easter party next month; Voiture 460

participated in Veterans Day Parade and had children's party for 300 kids, supported 1 nurse with a scholarship for \$3,500, has raffles to raise money, their jockey last night raised \$108 at the horse race; Voiture 760 had hot dogs and hand grenades and did good; Voiture 1321 will start up their cookout next month; Voiture 1292 will spend \$8,000 in nurses training, they have a golf tournament each year to help support their nurses training, had a Christmas party for 200 special needs kids, have BBQ's to raise money, looking for new PG's that will be active; Voiture 1379 will have their Chick Nic and has two nurses in training, are at 100%; Voiture 1541 had their Night at the Races and had a good turnout, sponsor 3 nurses for \$1,200, held their annual Christmas party and were honored by Grand Chef de Gare Calvin and his wife plus they brought Robert Emery.

Grand Medicin Tommy Thomas said he examined the PG's yesterday and found them healthy and they survived the wreck.

Grand Garde de la Porte Vincent Rost has collected \$157 in fines so far.

Grand Avocat Grant Willis said Voitures 333, 292, and 1379 had turned in new Constitutions and are awaiting Voiture Nationale approval.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Terry McDonald said he still has 2019 pins if anyone wanted any let him know. Everyone should keep track of their time. Reports are due June 15, 2019.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities Charles Kuehnel took over for Mike Brueckmann, who had to resign for health reasons.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley said Nurses Training is doing good. There have been one Boland Trust nurses training scholarship approved and there maybe two more applications coming in.

Grand Aumonier Rose Noonan said to send her information on those sick or deceased and to send her the Voiture's deceased for the Grand Promenade memorial service.

Grand Conducteur Jim Rosenberg said there were 7 PG's wrecked yesterday. The PG's collected about \$335. This money should go to nurses training. It was decided to send this money to the Boland Trust Fund.

Grand Directeur Americanism Bob Emery said reports are due June 15, 2019.

Grand Directeur Box Car Ernie Parker said he 59 pins have been sold.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA A. J. Noonan said he has a few 2019 pins if anyone wanted any let him know. Reports are due June 15, 2019.

Grand Directeur Youth Sports Ann Roberts said Voitures need to look at sponsoring individual athletics and teams. She has created a new form to be used to request funds from Nationale. She has some pins left.

Grand Sous Correspondant Grant Willis said the Grand Chef is so far sending in his articles on time. There will be 3 more issues this year. Send him information you want to be in the newsletter. He prefers a digital copy than a copy that has been made from a copy.

Time and Place Committee Committeeman Art Johnson said we be here at the Holiday Inn this year and next year will be back to the Oasis Hotel in Springfield for 2020.

Promenade Nationale Representative – Chip said we had a committee meeting Friday. It will be in Springfield 15 - 18, 2021. Let Art know if you know of any business that will buy and ad for the ad book.

Grand Directeur Special Awards Hallie Williams - Terry Lanning reported Hallie had to leave on Legion business but Terry has his report. Hallie recommended Terry Mancusi for Law Officer of the Year by Voiture 1541 and Michael Warden for Hero of the Year by Voiture 1321. Terry offered a notion to accept Hallie's recommendation, seconded by Janice and passed.

Old Business – none

New Business – Chef Bumgarner made the following appointments for the Grand Promenade committee chairmen: Nominations Kevin Johnson, Resolutions Art Wilson, Credentials Janice Harley, Constitution Bob Phillips, and Audit Terry McDonald with committeemen Bob Emery and David Christian. Terry Lanning offered a notion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Janice and passed. Chef Bumgarner recommends to appoint Charles Kuehnel as Grand Directeur Voiture Activities, since Mike Brueckmann resigned. Terry offered a notion to accept the Chefs appointment seconded by Grant and passed.

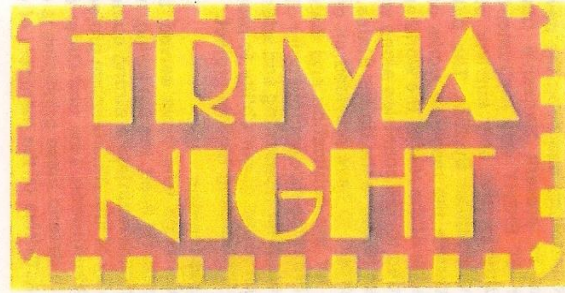
