SPRING GRANDE CHEMINOT, April 07, 2024
Oasis Hotel & Convention Center, Springfield, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Mike Scruby, opened the Spring Grande Cheminot at 9:00 AM surprisingly with his Gavel he remembered to bring with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a prayer by Grand Aumonier Ted McCart.

Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that thirteen answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed we had a quorum with eleven Voitures represented. Fines collected for those answering incorrectly. Absent were Voitures 38, 966, 1402 and 1403.

Grand Chef de Gare Mike Scruby recognized Kevin Johnson Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer.

Grand Avocat Richard Heigert said just like last time we will follow the Voiture Nationale Constitution and then Roberts's rules.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by Ben Sargent, that the Fall Grande Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant AJ Noonan said he received a flyer for Paul J. Emmert Sr candidate for Chef de Chemin de Fer. Ad for Central States from Grande du Missouri was sent to Grande du Texas. Received 100% membership pins for Voiture 966 Chef de Gare and Correspondant. Packets for Grand Directeurs are located in the back for pickup. They contain the Certificates to be awarded during the Grande Promenade in June.

Grand Correspondant AJ Noonan stated he had received the following resolutions: Ron Leverenz for Grand Chef de Gare, Rose Noonan for Grand Chef de Train, Ben Sargent for Commissaire Intendent and AJ Noonan for Grand Correspondant. Action on these resolutions will be at the Grande Promenade.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Rose Noonan, read the finance report and discussed it. Notion offered by Ben Sargent to accept the finance report subject to audit, second by Ron Turner... passed.

Grand Chef de Train Ron Leverenz reported the Grande had a membership of 596, 87.4%. Sous Grand Chef de Train's Hallie Williams (Voiture 38,448,966 and 1541) was at 84.1%, David Voyles (Voiture 3, 130, 1379 and 1402) was at 88.33%, Dan Levasseur (Voiture 292, 333, 1292 and 1403) was at 94.4% and Ron Turner (Voiture 460, 760 and 1321) was at 80.9%. Need 86 renewals / new members to be at 100%.

Cheminot Nationale AJ Noonan had nothing to report.

Some of the highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 130 is selling their towels, sponsored two Boys Scout Troops, sponsoring Boys and Girls State and Oratorical Contests along with Grave Decorations, have 34 of 38 members paid for 89.4%; Voiture 292 are at 90%, they help St. James and Mexico Nursing Homes and VA Hospital; Voiture 333; Membership: 98%* 102 of 104 anticipate at least 1 new member next meeting and possibly 2. Flags for 1st Graders: over 1000 flags to over 35 schools. Nursing scholarships: 14 to be awarded totaling \$10,000. JROTC scholarships: new scholarships for Sedalia Smith-Cotton Army JROTC and Triad Air Force JROTC. Selected by instructors and going to cadet going to a trade school. 75th Anniversary Boxcar celebration planning continues. Mozarkfest September 21-23 on State Fairgrounds will include the Vietnam Traveling Wall, 3 nights of concerts, 2 car shows .and much more. Voiture 448 provided gifts to kids at Mary Grove Childrens Home for Christmas and Easter. May Day Parade on 19 May in downtown St. Louis. Promenade held every other month. Murder Mystery Dinner on June 15, 2024 at Creve Coeur American Legion Post 397. Dinner starts at 5:30pm with the Murder Mystery Show following. Memberships is currently at 56%; Voiture 460 membership is at 86.4%. Awarded three Nursing Training Scholarships for \$500 Participated in Veterans Day placement of flags at 5 local cemeteries. Participated in the Veterans Day Parade in St. Robert. Participated in Christmas Parade in St. James with Veterans from the St. James Veterans Home. Donated \$500 for Shop with a Cop for Community Service for Christmas; Americanism: 2- \$200 gift cards to Support Veterans (Health Issues). Child Welfare Support: \$280 for the Foster Closets to support Child Welfare. 4 Voyageurs went thru the Spring Wreck yesterday. Voiture 760 attended Flag Raising Ceremony; membership is at 72%. Voiture 1292 bought \$400 in gifts for Veterans for Veterans Day. Provided 356 bags each worth \$25 and handed them out to Special Needs Children for Christmas along with handing out 115 - \$5 gift cards to teachers and aides; will not have a sausage sale this year due to cost and limited profits; hosting their 1st Sunday Breakfast on 14 April – proceeds will go to Nurses Training Scholarships and the Special Needs Christmas; 1 Voyageur went thru the Wreck bringing total membership to 72 of 73; awarded 6 additional Nurses Training Scholarships for \$750 each bringing the total to 18 for the year; this year's golf tournament is on 13 July with proceeds going to Nurses Training.; Voiture 1379 has 1 nurse in training, Membership is 35 of 37; have 2 Voyageurs that volunteer their time each week at the VA hospital and bring information back to share with the Voiture. Voiture 1541 has 3 nurses in training with 1

graduating this Spring but plan on adding 1 more, have 47 members paid for a 87% percent renewal. Purchased 5 wreaths for Wreaths Across America at Jefferson Barracks Cemetery. Voyageur Don Newman assisted the newly opened Satellite VA Clinic in St. Charles setting up a Coffee Cart and approving the display of the POW/MIA flag at the clinic, had a Christmas party along with Salon #771 in which 46 attended at the Wentzville American Legion Post. Approved donations of \$150 for American Legion Post #312 Baseball Trivia Night, \$100 towards Moolah Shrine Circus and \$100 towards St. Charles Devil Dogs Golf Tournament. Held their Annual "Night at the Races" and raised \$2700. Four Voyageurs have passed away this year.

Grand Medicin Tommy Thomas said 6 PGs went through the Spring Wreck and there were no injuries.

Grand Historien Frank Angelo said if any Locales have pictures they would like to include in the Grande History book send them to him.

Grand Avocat Richard Heigert had no report but will be collecting dues for Chef de Gare Passes. Can pay immediately after the Cheminot.

Grand Directeur Voiture Activities Calvin Bumgarner said to put info into reports so he can consolidate.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Kevin Johnson said to capture all information and send to him by 15 June.

Grand Aumonier Ted McCart said to send him the names of the deceased so he can put them in the Memorial program at the Grand Promenade.

Grand Conducteur Frank Angelo said there were 6 PG's wrecked and said he estimated the PG's collected over \$100 in coins. All of the money the PG's collected and the fines from this Grande Cheminot will go to General Fund to help pay a new banner. Wanted to thank all the Sous Conducteurs who supported the Wreck.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA Janice Hartley: Grande du Missouri has had \$88 in 2024 pins and donations to Nationale. Attended POW/MIA ceremonies. Time and mileage should be reported on your annual report if an event attended has a POW/MIA table present. Send annual reports by 31 May.

Grand Directeur Special Awards Ben Sargent said he has not received a Law Officer of the Year from or City of Year submissions but received a Voyageur of the Year award submission from Voiture 1321.

Grand Directeur VAVS Chip Berkley reiterated the importance of sending reports in and accounting for volunteer hours at the VA Hospitals.

Time and Place Committee Kevin Johnson said the Grand Promenade and Cheminot will be June 28-30 2024 at Oasis Hotel in Springfield at \$109 and the Grand Chef's Homecoming and Cheminot will be October 13-15, 2023 at same hotel and rate. Central States Promenade will be in Kerrville, TX April 17- 20 2024, 105th Promenade Nationale is September 17-21, 2024 at Kalahari Resorts Sandusky, OH. Spring Wreck 2025 and Grande Promenade contracts are pending and will be announced during Grande Promenade in June.

Distinguished Voyageur Award Calvin Bumgarner Chairman said he received one nomination for Voyageur of the Year - Harry T. Barnes from Voiture 1321. Nomination was read and voted on. Ralph Turner offered a notion to accept nomination seconded by Kevin Johnson. Passed. Ben Sargent asked that participation form be sent to him.

Old Business: none

New Business:

- Grand Chef Mike Scruby made the following Grand Promenade Committee appointments: Constitution Bob Phillips; Nominations Kevin Johnson; Credentials Ron Leverenz; Resolutions David Bexten and Audit Chairman David Voyles with Frank Angelo and Terry Lanning. offered a notion to approve the appointments second by John Kramer and passed.
- Discussion on Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer visiting the Grande in June in addition to Chef de Chemin de Fer Frank Campo. Notion was made by David Voyles and seconded by Terry Lanning to pay for the Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer room and banquet pending confirmation he will be staying in hotel and attending banquet. Passed
- Ed Jones requested the Grand send a letter of appreciation to Voiture Nationale recognizing the three ladies that support the Grande and our Voitures. Notion was made by Ed Jones and seconded by Dan Levasseur. Passed

- Rich Heigert addressed the cost of the banquet was more than what was collected from Registration fees and that cost would be charged to Ron Leverenz to cover. The cost would be \$2.40 more than what was collected due to 24% gratuity. Notion was rescinded by Rich Heigert for the Grande to cover that cost after discussion by Ron Leverenz. Additional issues were discussed and will be brought to the hotel management.

- Janice Hartley offered a notion for the Grande to order two new banners for Grande du Missouri for use during Cheminot/Promenades and Banquet. One banner is stained and the other banner has not been found. Discussion – Grand can not afford purchasing two at this time and Kevin Johnson requested the notion be revised to purchasing one banner now and one additional in September when our CD's are renewed. If second banner is found then there will be no need to purchase both. Janice Hartley revised her notion to purchase one now and second pending if needed. Seconded by Rich Heigert. Additional Discussion – where were the original banners purchased. Possibly Emblem Sales – being researched. Passed

Good of the Grande Voiture – Transfer of funds - \$600 from Grande du Missouri General Account into Central States Account. Kevin Johnson offered a notion seconded by Rich Heigert. Central States 2025 Account will be setup with Rich Heigert, Ted Mc cart and AJ Noonan with the Bank of Versailles. Passed. AJ Noonan said eight Voitures paid the fines/registration for the Cornhole Fundraiser. Total received was \$400 going into the General Fund. Voiture 760 won the Cornhole Tournament. It may have been rigged. Still questionable. Frank Angelo stated that the Voyageurs who went thru the Wreck raised approximately \$296 in collections – asked if he would guarantee that amount. Frank said yes. \$127.00 was collected in fines. Kevin Johnson offered a notion for all money collected during the Wreck and this weekend in fines be put in the General Account due to Central States startup and the new banner costs. Seconded by Ben Sargent. Discussion: none. Passed.
