



FALL GRAND CHEMINOT, SEPTEMBER 29, 2012 TRUMAN Hotel, Jefferson City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare, Ed Jones, opened the Fall Grand Cheminot sharply at 1:00 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier, John Paul Kopp.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest were incompliant. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that ten answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 520, 966, and 1395.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by Virgil Morice, that the Grand Promenade and Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning gave the minutes of the Executive Meeting, which was held on September 29, 2012, at 9:11am (just a little late). The budget was read by Leon Hill. Discussed the budget and Rich Heigert offered a notion to accept the budget, seconded by Ray Brodzinski and passed. Also discussed the budget having a deficient and possible action to take. Our raffle sales dropped about 45% from the prior year so we need to push the raffle tickets better. A Dues increase was discussed. Decided to revisit the deficient at the Spring Cheminot. Discussed if the Grand would want to host a National Promenade. It would require everyone across the state to help. A possible location would be Branson. Nationale is working on detailed information to tell anyone hosting a Nationale Promenade what they are responsible for and possible costs. The Spring Wreck and Cheminot will now be April 12 to 14, 2013 since our original date fell during Easter. Executive meeting closed 10:08am. Ray Brodzinski offered a notion to accept Executive meeting minutes, seconded by Virgil Morice... passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning told everyone that the new yearbooks and envelopes for the Grand Directeurs are in the back of the room, as well as travel chits for Grand Officers. Also had a resolution for someone for Honorary Grand Chef de Gare. This resolution will be passed onto the Past Grand Chefs to discuss.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Leon Hill, stated that the finance report was passed out and discussed it. Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, second by David Christian, to accept the Finance report subject to audit...passed. Leon then discussed the budget. Notion offered by Ray Brodzinski, seconded by David Christian to accept the budget... passed.

Grand Chef de Train, Ralph Turner, reported on the current Grande membership. The Grande has 434 members, 37%. Ralph had passed out a listing of 10 members in Missouri from Voiture 2000. This would be a good source of members. Everyone needs to sign someone up.

Grand Cheminot reports were given by Voiture 130, 292, 448, 460, 760, 1292, 1321, 1379, 1402, and 1541. Some of the highlights are Voiture 130 sold towels to raise funds for their nurses training, have 14 nurses; Voiture 448 will have a kids xmas party; Voiture 460 has 11 Nurses in Training, sponsored two baseball teams for \$750, helped kids with doctors visits, donated \$6,000 for American Legion Building Fund and Veterans Cemetery, sponsored a dinner with the American Legion, donated \$3,300 to assist Missouri Veterans Home and disabled veterans; Voiture 760 donated to the Springfield reunion Club; Voiture 1292 will be having a Christmas party for special kids on 12/11/12, had a June BBQ fundraiser; Voiture 1321 will have their cooker out, have 5 nurses in training; Voiture 1379 had to cancel their ChickNick due to the heat, the Grand Chef Ed Jones installed their Officers; Voiture 1402 has 3 Nurses in Training, they take wash towel to Veterans Home; Voiture 1541 has 4 nurses in training, had their installation in August, had their Car Show in August, sponsored one boy to Boys State, Christmas party will be 12/19/12 at Wentzville Legion Post, Wild Game Coon Supper 1/19/13 at Wentzville Legion Post, and Night at the Races 3/2/13 at St. Charles American Legion Post.

Terry Lanning said, on behalf of Grand Avocat Rich Heigert, Voiture Nationale had conditionally approved the Grand Constitution changes. Their suggested changes were approved at the Grand Promenade and were sent into Voiture Nationale. Waiting on approval.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Jim Hartley said each Grande can have one at large Boland Scholarship. He will work on the procedures as to how to pick one.

Grand Directeur Child Welfare Hallie Williams says to let him know how many pins each Voiture wants.

Alternate Cheminot Nationale David Christian reported on the Nationale Promenade. David gave out the new password. Terry Lanning attended the Voiture Activities meeting and said they are going to try to clarify the instruction (we've heard that before). Terry also attended the Finance Meeting and said new procedures for National Officers travel to Nationale Promenade were approved. Ralph went to Public Relations meeting and said we need to get the 40/8 name on the street. Grant went to the Box Car meeting and said the Box Car raised more money this year so they gave away more money. Grant also went to POW/MIA meeting and they gave out 18 scholarships. Janice attended the Special Awards meeting and said there were 32 submissions for the 4 awards. Barry Bovee was elected Chef de Chemin de Fer, he is from Michigan. Grant Willis was appointed National Secretary/Treasurer POW/MIA and Terry Lanning was elected Commissaire Intendant National.

Grand Organizer Robert Phillips said the northeast does not have any Voitures in that area and he has contacted Ira Chandler to see about starting one up.

Grand Conducteur Chris Bryson said he to let him know if anyone is bringing PG's to the wreck or props. At the Spring wreck banquet there will be a fashion show. A male voyageur will dress up as a woman, one per Voiture but not a new PG. Money raised will go to the Grande.

Grand Directeur Americanism Bob Emery said he had new pins if anyone wanted any.

Grand Directeur Box Car, John Paul Kopp, said he has pins and there is a new coin that the Box Car is selling.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA Gary Reno said he had new pins if anyone wanted any. He plans on having a POW/MIA table at each of the banquets.

Grand Directeur Ritual, Ed Schmidt, stated to let him know if there are any questions or if he can help.

Time & Place Committee, Bob Eisenbath, reported that the Spring Grande Wreck and Cheminot would be in Springfield Ramada Oasis, on April 12-14, 2013. Grande Promenade (June 28-30, 2013) and the Fall Grand Cheminot & Homecoming (September 27-29, 2013) will also be held there.

Old Business - none New Business - none

Distinguished Voyageur Award Chairman Ray Brodzinski said to get the nominations in.

Distinguished Guest Committeeman Terry Lanning said he would send an invitation to Voiture Nationale for a National Officer to attend Truman Day.

Good of the Grande Voiture - David Christian said Junior has returned, he was lost for a little while. John Kopp offered a notion to donate half of the fine money to Gary Reno to offset the cost of putting on the POW/MIA exhibit at the banquets, seconded and passed.

Grand Chef de Gare Christian closed the Fall Grand Cheminot in the proper manner at 3:05 PM.

- Maintain the current funding for the operation and maintenance of state veterans homes and state veterans cemeteries, veterans' capital improvement projects, the Veterans Service Organizations' Service Officer Grant Program and other needs of Missouri's veterans;
- Work with the Missouri Veterans Commission to develop a long range plan to meet the changing needs for the Missouri veterans' community now and into the future;
- Support MODoT signage for the VA Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC) in Missouri;
- Support legislation to establish Veterans Treatment Courts throughout Missouri;
- Support legislation to offer interest free small business loans for newly returned military veterans and provide assistance for small business owners who are veterans;
- Establish a viable and enforceable Veterans Employment Program;
- Support creation of a "Woman Veteran" license plate;
- Support any other legislation introduced in the legislature determined by the MAVO Legislative Committee to be in the interest of veterans
