Fall Grande Cheminot, October 5, 2024
Oasis Convention Center, Springfield, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare Ron Leverenz, opened the Fall Grand Cheminot at 1:00 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a prayer by Grand Aumonier Ted McCart.

Grand Chef de Gare Ron Leverenz recognized Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer Ralph Turner and asked if he would like to sit at the head table which he respectfully declined.

Grand Correspondant conducted roll call of officers. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed twelve were present. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed eleven were present. We had a quorum. Absent were Voitures 38, 966, 1402 and 1403.

Grand Avocat Rich Heigert said we will follow the Promenade Voiture Nationale rules and then Roberts's rules of order.

Notion offered by Kevin Johnson, seconded by Ralph Turner, that the Grand Promenade and Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...Passed.

Grand Correspondant AJ Noonan gave the minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting, held October 5, 2024, at 9:00am. Attendees include Chef de Gare Ron Leverenz, Chef de Train Rose Noonan, Commissaire Intendant Ben Sargent, Correspondant AJ Noonan, Cheminot-at-Large Terry Lanning, Ralph Turner and Kevin Johnson. Additional attendees were Chef de Gare Passe Rich Heigert, Frank Angelo, Ed Jones, Dave Bexten, Hallie Williams, Janice Hartley, Calvin Bumgarner and Grand Director Nurses Training Dan Levasseur. The budget was presented by Ben Sargent. Kevin Johnson offered a notion to accept the budget as printed, seconded by Rich Heigert ... passed. Discussed what fundraiser we should have at the Spring Wreck. Decided to do Cornhole with Chip Berkley and Frank Angelo in charge. AJ Noonan will bring two cornhole sets/boards. If a Voiture does not participate then there will be a \$50 fine. The participation cost is \$50 per Voiture. It was decided the Grande should invite Chef de Chemin de Fer Paul Emmert Sr. to the Grande Cheminot and Wreck with Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer Ralph Turner as alternate. Grand Correspondant AJ Noonan will send Voiture Nationale Visit Request. The Executive Committee agreed to charge an additional five dollars for the banquet (\$40 total) and Registration Fee (\$15 total) to prevent out of pocket expense to Chef de Train / Chef de Gare contractual requirements. Rich Heigert offered a notion second by Terry Lanning – passed. The Executive Committee closed the meeting at 9:25am. Notion by Mike Scruby to approve the minutes seconded by Robert Emery and passed.

Grand Correspondant AJ Noonan stated the new yearbooks are in the back as well as travel chits voucher for Grande Officers. There were no Resolution presented.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, Ben Sargent, read the proposed budget and finance report. The current balance of Now Checking Account as of 05 Oct 2024 is \$3,560.49. Notions offered by Kevin to accept the budget and the finance report, second by Ralph Turner... passed.

Grand Chef de Train Rose Noonan had two Sous Chef de Trains present. Sous Grand Chef de Train's Ted McCart (Voiture 460, 760 and 1321) and Lora Berkley (Voiture 292, 333, 1292 and 1403) presented their membership numbers for their respective Voitures. Goal is to achieve 100% membership again this year.

Cheminot Nationale Halle Williams said the password did not change for the upcoming year. Awards from Promenade Nationale were presented by Chef de Gare Ron Leverenz. Recognition to Grande du Missouri for Child Welfare and Voiture 130 for excellence in Nurses Training. Alternate Cheminot Nationale Mike Scruby had no report.

Highlights of the Grand Cheminot reports are: Voiture 130 reported on current Voiture Activities to include participating in 10 funerals, flag ceremony for the third-grade class at Mini Cline Elementary discussing history of the flag, proper etiquette; posted the Colors at the Grand Opening of Savannah High School refurbished football field; sponsoring 2 Boy Scout Troops, Memorial Day Services, Veterans Home Activities. Membership is currently at 69%. Voiture 292 one Nurses Training Scholarship for \$1000, 21 paid members so far this year, Fisher House activities scheduled for 19 Oct 2024. Voiture 333 purchased trophies for Smith Cotton Army JROTC and Cadet of the Month awards for \$4100; participated in Sedalia 4th of July Parade and opening day State Fair Parade; Boxcar was repainted prior to State Fair; Voyageurs were present each day; total of 52 paid members to date which includes 5 new Voyageurs; Chef de Gare Cliff McBride was Master of Ceremonies at opening and closing ceremonies during State Fair; presented a \$1000 check to the Boys and Girls Club. Voiture 448 meets at Post 208 in Ballwin, Mo on the 4th Tuesday, Christmas Party is scheduled for December; currently sponsoring one Nurses Training Scholarship; participating in the Veterans Day Parade on 9 November in St. Louis with Marygrove Children's Home also participating. Voiture 460 activities include

monthly Promenade, Cemetery flag placement and sponsoring three Nurses. Raffle is ongoing to raise money for the program fund. Voiture 1292 conducted a Golf Tournament raising over \$17,000, conducting monthly breakfast; received a Grant for \$10,000 to be used for Nurses Training; planning a Special Needs Christmas party and sponsoring 6 Nurses. Voiture 1321 conducts BBQ fundraiser which sponsors 5 nurses and 1 boy for Missouri Boy State; conducted bingo at Jefferson Barracks Hospital for 55 patients. Voiture 1541 has 3 nurses in training, currently at 80% Membership, 36 paid members; lost 2 Voyageurs; Christmas party at Wentzville Post on December 18th, Night at Races will be March 1, 2025, at St. Charles Legion Post 313.

Grand Directeur Nurses Training Dan Levasseur recognized Kevin Johnson and Ralph Turner and looks forward to working with them this year.

Grand Drapeau East Janice Hartley discussed the need to purchase a second banner since the missing one has still not been found. Will address under new business.

Grand Conducteur Frank Angelo. Stated as we get closer to Spring Wreck. Send list of PG's so we can plan accordingly.

Grand Directeur Boxcar. John Kramer was not present, but Grand Correspondant provided his report. He has 50 pins available to purchase. Voitures can contact him.

Grand Directeur Carville Star. Roger Wallenberg stated he had pins for sale.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA Frank Angelo attended POW/MIA committee meeting at Promenade Nationale. If you want pins let him know – does not have any on consignment but will if Voitures are interested.

Grand Chairman VAVS Chip Berkley. Thanked everyone who sent end of year report. Only 14 Grandes submitted report to Voiture Nationale. Good reporting by Locales this year.

Time and Place Committee: Kevin Johnson said the Spring Wreck and Grand Cheminot will be April 4-6, 2025, at Oasis Hotel Springfield room rates will be \$114 plus tax. The registration fee is \$15 and banquet costs \$40. Grand Promenade and Cheminot 2025 will be July 4-6, 2025, same hotel and rate (\$114) and the Grand Chef's Homecoming and Cheminot will be October 10-11, 2025, at same hotel and rate. Central States Promenade will be held on May 8-10, 2025, in Springfield MO. Room rates are \$114 single and double occupancy. Registration fee increased to \$95 and the Luncheon cost will be \$30. 106th Promenade Nationale will be in Gettysburg, PA September 23-27, 2025. Room rates are \$120; registration is \$30 before June 1st, 2025; \$35 afterwards. The banquet is \$45.

Grand Correspondant failed to call on Kevin Johnson for the Executive Committee Advisory & Protocol. Will be fixed next time. Duly noted. Fine was paid.

Committee Reports from Promenade Nationale:

Ralph Turner attended the Nurses Training Committee meeting. Pin sales were approximately \$4,000. Approved \$1000 for Nurse of the Year donation. Approved \$8,000 to go to the Boland Trust. Kevin Johnson appointed the National Directeur of Nurses Training and Ralph Turner appointed as the Treasurer. Kevin Johnson said a new scholarship 2-\$1000 scholarship for Sophomores. Criteria is being developed and he is working with his Sous to present next year. Grande du Missouri received Honorable Mention. Voiture 130 received the Anderson Award for Nurses Training. Voiture 1292 recognized also.

Kevin Johnson mentioned Ritual and Joel Bunch Award. None were received at Natioinale.

Frank Angelo attended the Membership Committee meeting. Working on Super Recruiter award. Tabled until next year. Also attend POW/MIA Committee meeting. A total of 12 Scholarships were awarded. Over 62,891 volunteer hours and 432, 625 miles traveled. Total monetary value over \$678, 000. Voted and approved the scholarships change from Great Grandchild to Great-great Grandchild. Finance Committee: new budget provided. Old building was sold. New building paid in full.

Hallie Williams attended Child Welfare. Has 40 pins available. 30 pins already sold.

Chip Berkley attended VAVS Committee. Only 14 Grandes reported this year. Ritual Committee – no change to password. Discussed possible changes to the Ritual Manual.

Mike Scruby attended Carville Star Committee meeting. 30 Voyageurs attended. Remodeled the museum. Hanson Disease was discussed. 150-200K reported cases in 145 countries.

Lora Berkley attended Youth Sports Committee. Pins are available for \$4 each. Coins are \$10. Only 11 Grandes submitted reports this past year. Reporting was poor. 1095 teams were supported last year.

John Kramer attended Box Car, Historian, Americanism and Voiture Activities Committee meetings. Box Car: 36 members in attendance. 12 reports were received this year. Missouri did not win any awards this past year. Historian: Only one book was received. Ben Sargent stated the Committee voted to add a Pin Class beside history book. Pins can be on a vest or mounted on a display board. Americanism: Main topic discussed was Flags for First Graders. Voiture Activities: 76 Voyageurs and 13 Grands represented. Voyageurs participating: 18,414, 7852 events; total dollars \$766,453 and mileage 1,053,223. Also discussed rolling stock is

any vehicle that has 40 and 8 identification and transports 2 or more Voyageurs participating in Parades or other activities.

Ben Sargent attended Special Awards. If a city is submitted City of the Year (COY) and does not win. Must wait three years to resubmit. Law Officer of the Year (LOY) submissions. If individual doesn't win at Grande at least recognize at the Locale Level.

Kevin Johnson mentioned that Voiture Activities is no longer a National Program. The Blue Chevaliers was postponed from being added due primarily to financial and legal documentation. Will probably be added next year.

Old Business – Banner has been purchased.

New Business – Nationale Officers from Missouri were Ralph Turner Sous Chef de Chemin de Fer and National Treasurer Nurses Training, Kevin Johnson National Directeur Nurses Training, Frank Angelo Directeur Membership and AJ Noonan Advisory Committee.

Good of the Grande Voiture – Kevin Johnson offered a notion that all fines received will go to the purchase of the second banner. No stand is required, Seconded by Robert Emery. Passed. Grand Conducteur Frank Angelo stated he has received \$93 in fines so far. More possibly at the banquet.

Distinguished Guest Ralph Turner had no words of wisdom for the Grande.

Grand Chef de Gare Ron Leverenz closed the Fall Grand Cheminot in the proper manner at 2:48 PM.
